ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1) ST. MICHAEL'S TERRACE, N22 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER 2007

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey, to allow for water main replacement works in St. Michael's Terrace, N22, intends to make an Order to enable the works to be carried out. 2. The general effect of the Order would be to prohibit vehicles from entering and proceeding along St. Michael's Terrace at its junction with Buckingham Road 3. Whilst the prohibition remains in operation, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter and proceed at the locations specified in Article 2 of this notice. 4. The provisions specified in Article 2 above, shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may be indicated by appropriate traffic signs. 5. During the duration of the works the existing one way working along St Michael's Terrace and Terrick Road, N22 will be suspended to allow for two-way traffic flow. 6. The Order shall come into operation on the 8th October 2007 and would be valid for a maximum period of 3 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. The works are scheduled to be completed by end of October 2007. 7. Persons having a query concerning this Order should contact Traffic and Road Safety on 020 8489 1763. 8. Nothing in this Order shall apply to: (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the said works; (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The A503 GLA Road (Tollington Road and Parkhurst Road, London Borough of Islington) (Temporary Suspension of Bus Lane and Parking Bays) Order 2007

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3. 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable works to take place on the A503 Tollington Road to upgrade a junction and the A503 Parkhurst Road to construct a new pedestrian crossing. 3. The effect of the Order will be to: (a) suspend the bus lane on the A503 Parkhurst Road between Chambers Road and the A1 Holloway Road; and to prevent stopping on the south-east side of the extended common boundary of Nos 57 and 59 Parkhurst Road and a point 4 metres north-east of the extended common boundary of Nos 61 and 63 Parkhurst Road; (b) and to prevent stopping on the A503 Tollington Road between its junction with Hornsey Road and the common boundary of Nos 70 and 72 Tollington Road. The Order will be effective from 00:01 hours on 15th October 2007 to 23:59 hours on 14th December 2007 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of: (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant.
