NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY TO DESIGNATE A STREET FOR LICENSED STREET TRADING

Notice is hereby given that it is the intention of Islington Borough Council's Street Trading Section within the Public Protection Department, to apply to the Licensing Regulatory Committee to pass a resolution to designate for street trading purposes, the following areas, as outlined below:

- 1 St John's Grove, in the carriageway within the Pay and Display bays, located outside of the Church. Every Saturday from 9am until 6pm.
- 2 Holloway Road, on the Footway, outside No 619 639. Every Thursday from 12pm to 6pm, and every Saturday from 9am until 6pm.

It is proposed that the Council's Licensing Regulatory Committee meeting on Wednesday 5th December 2007 at 2.30pm in Islington Town Hall, Upper Street, London N1, will consider this application. Anyone wishing to object to the application must give notice within four weeks of this publication, specifying the grounds of objection. On the hearing of the said application, any person to whom notice is given, any person who uses the said highway and any other person who would be aggrieved by the making of the Order to which this application relates, shall have the right to be heard.
