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**Subject: PREMISES LICENCE NEW APPLICATION**  
**Farringdon Grill, 98 Farringdon Road, London EC1R 3EA**

**1. Synopsis**

- 1.1 This is an application for a new premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The new application is to allow:
  - 1.2.01 the provision of late night refreshment: 2300 to 0200 on Sundays to Wednesdays and 23:00 to 03:00 on Thursdays to Saturdays.
- 1.3 This premises is located outside of the Clerkenwell cumulative impact policy area.

**2. Recommendations**

- 2.1 To determine the application for a new premises licence under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
  - i. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (See appendix 3);
  - ii. conditions recommended by responsible Authorities (see appendix 3);
  - iii. any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

### **3. Background**

3.1 Papers are attached as follows:-

- Appendix 1: application form;
- Appendix 2a: list of persons making representations;
- Appendix 2: representations;
- Appendix 3: suggested conditions and map of premise location.

3.2 The Licensing Authority received three letters of representation: one from a local resident, one from the responsible authority for public safety and one from Islington's Noise Team. Both responsible authorities have subsequently withdrawn their representations as the applicant has agreed to the imposition of their respective proposed conditions.

3.3 The resident has reported that the extraction unit attached to the premises is a source of smell and noise nuisance. The Licensing Team have referred the matter to the Environmental Health Team for further investigation.

3.4 The Planning Team have reported that the current extraction flue is unlikely to contravene planning laws by virtue of established use. Furthermore any material alterations to the current appearance of the flue will probably require planning permission.

3.5 The premises is located in Clerkenwell Ward, just outside of the cumulative impact policy area, which will therefore not apply to this application. There is however an area specific policy that applies to Clerkenwell and Bunhill and this should be taken into account when considering licence applications in these Wards.

3.6 Applicants with premises in Clerkenwell and Bunhill are expected to demonstrate in their operating schedules how they intend to reduce the potential negative impacts on residents such as:

- arrangements to prevent crime and disorder emanating from the premises and escalating in the area;
- steps that the applicants intends to take to educate their customers and prevent public nuisance arising from illegally dumped waste and litter, and prevent the use of alleyways, street corners, and open pavements in the vicinity of their premises as urinals;
- applicants' intention to be active members of the pub watch, or shop watch schemes operating in this area;
- a regard for the nature of the area and provision of premises that will be welcomed by the wider community;
- clear evidence of the arrangements that will be put in place to ensure that early morning deliveries and collections will not cause a nuisance to residents
- smoking and drinking outside premises is well managed;
- the applicant's intention to adopt the Licensees' Charter.

### **4. Conclusion and reasons for recommendations**

4.1 The Council is required to consider this application in the light of all relevant information, and if approval is given, it may attach such conditions necessary to promote the licensing objectives.

Recordings shall be made available to an Authorised Officer or a Police Officer (subject to the Data Protection Act 1998) within 24 hours of any request.

**c) Public safety**

Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place along with appliances including fire extinguishers (Foam, H2O and CO2), fire blankets, internally illuminated fire exit signs, a smoke detector and emergency lighting. All appliances are checked annually and comply with relevant British Standards.

All fire escapes/escape routes will be clearly marked and kept free from obstructions at all times.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

All customers are asked to leave quietly. Clear and legible notices will be displayed to remind customers to leave quietly.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

To protect the children from harm we have following steps taken:

- 1- the premises are effectively and responsibly managed
- 2- provision of a sufficient number of people employed or engaged
- 3- appropriate instruction, training and supervision of those employed or engaged

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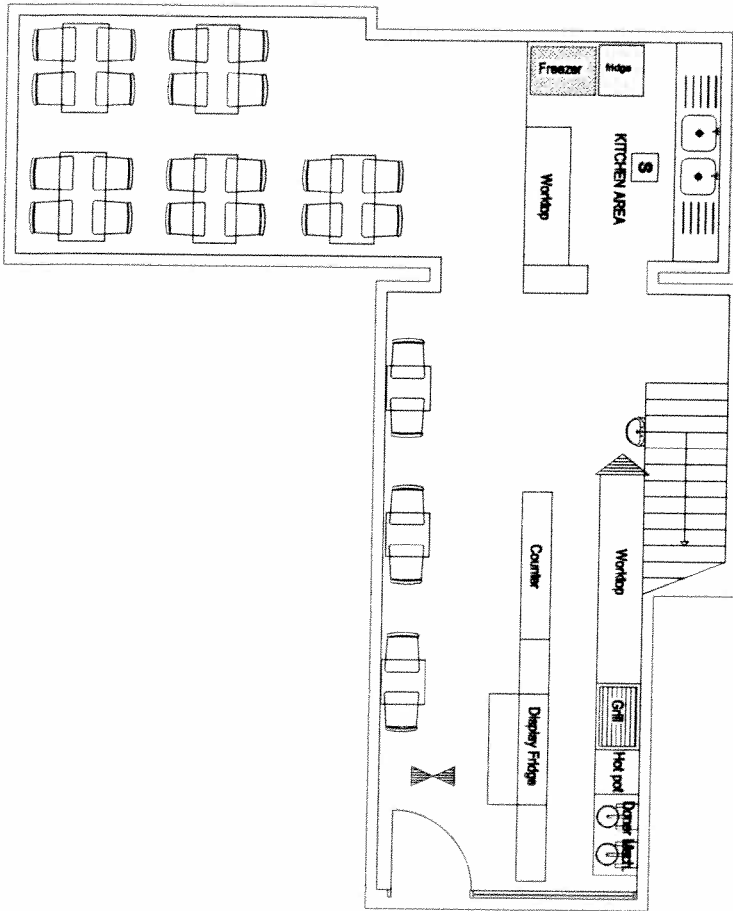

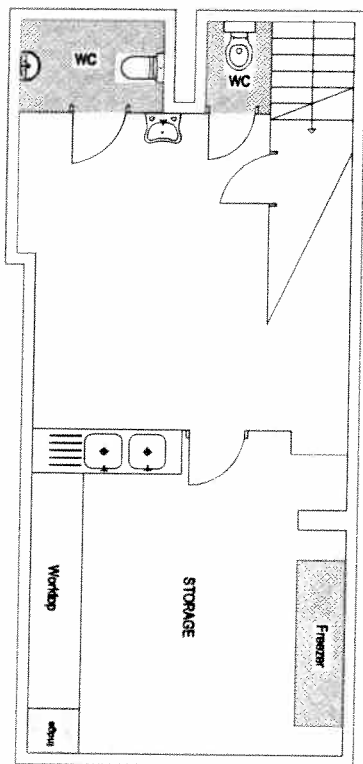

RE : The Farringdon Grill Licensing Act 2003 Ref WK/111236555 Objection to the late trading hours.

**Health:** The Farringdon Grill sells food that is deemed unhealthy and is related to obesity caused by an unhealthy life style. By granting a late license, the local government is seemingly working against the Government and NHS 's targets to reduce death by illness associated with obesity. By allowing the Grill to open late into the night, it will encourage the consumption of unhealthy food which is full of saturated fat.

**Nuisance :** Local residents can often find disposal of half eaten kebabs/ burgers near our address. People who are intoxicated, while consuming unhealthy food purchased from the Grill, congregate around the shop and immediate vicinity to our flats, causing nuisance e.g. noise and urinating, and on occasions defecating. The grill owner also has an extraction system which has been causing nuisance to residents living in the block of flats that is located behind the grill. Its current extraction system generates noise and choking smells (burning flesh) and smoke while it is in operation. Residents have approached the proprietor to ask them to show consideration by turning off the extractor when the grill is not in use. However, such request was ignored and the owner left the extractor on throughout its opening time i.e. often till 2 to 3am.

We for years have not been able to enjoy fresh air while sleeping due to the noise and smells from the extractor. We could only open the window when the Farringdon grill is not trading. During the last few weeks while the grill bar was not open late into the night, we managed to enjoy fresh air with our window open.

We propose the owner of the grill improve the extraction system in line with other local eatery / restaurant businesses if he wishes to extend trading hours. We propose the licensing team to put conditions in place that the owner install an extraction system which is raised to the roof of the building and face the outlet to the direction of Farringdon road where the flow of traffic and more open space could help disperse the smoke and smell. Also the construction of the chimney should be using a round tube rather than a box shape body to reduce vibration and noise and proper sound insulation for the motor of the extraction fan. Please see enclosed photos showing the current outlet chimneys in comparison to the other two more modern and environmentally sympathetic installations nearby.

**Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule**

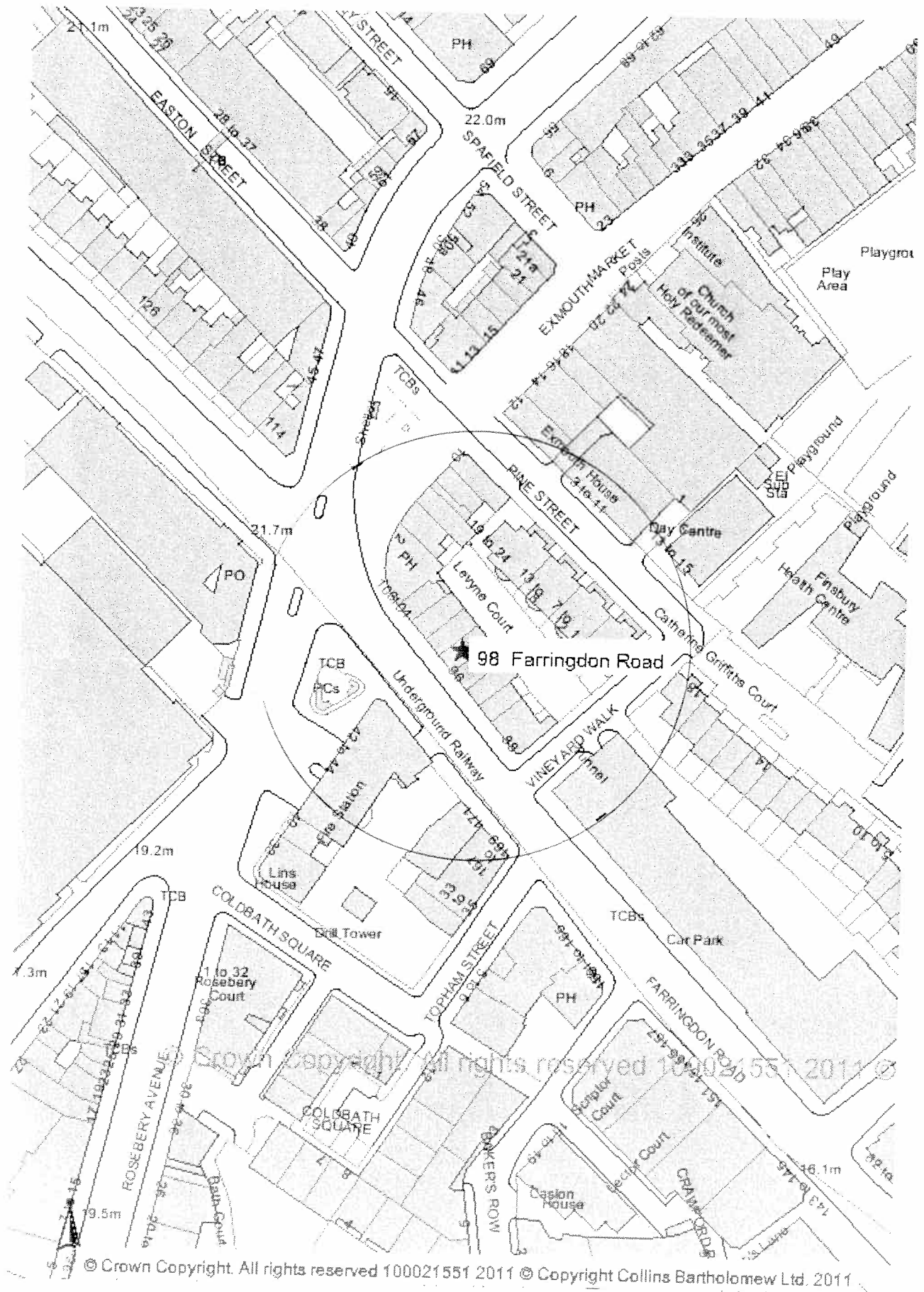
1. CCTV shall be installed, operated and maintained in agreement with the police. The system shall enable a frontal head and shoulders image of every person entering the premises. The system shall record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days. Recordings shall be made available to an Authorised Officer or a Police Officer (subject to the Data Protection Act 1998) within 24 hours of any request.
2. Appropriate fire safety procedures shall be maintained in place along with appliances including fire extinguishers (Foam, H2O and CO2), fire blankets, internally illuminated fire exit signs, a smoke detector and emergency lighting. All appliances shall be checked annually and comply with relevant British Standards.
3. All fire escapes/escape routes shall be clearly marked and kept free from obstructions at all times.
4. All customers shall be asked to leave quietly. Clear and legible notices shall be displayed to remind customers to leave quietly.
5. To protect children from harm the licensee shall take steps to ensure:
  - i) the premises are effectively and responsibly managed;
  - ii) the provision of a sufficient number of people employed or engaged;
  - iii) appropriate instruction, training and supervision of those employed or engaged.

**Suggested conditions of approval recommended by Noise Team (agreed).**

6. No deliveries will take place on Sundays or Bank Holiday and between the hours of 10pm and 7am other days of the week.
7. No rubbish including bottles will be moved, removed or placed in outside area on Sunday or Bank Holiday and between the hours of 10pm and 7am other days of the week
8. Doors to the premises to be kept closed between 11pm and 8am
9. Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.

**Suggested conditions of approval recommended by Health and Safety Officer (agreed)**

10. The premises shall not be used under the licence until the requirements specified in the schedule dated 6 December 2011 have been completed and approved in writing by the responsible authority for health and public safety.



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
