Subject: PREMISES LICENCE VARIATION APPLICATION
RE: Somerfield Stores Limited, 185 Old Street, London EC1V 9NP

1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is an application for the variation of a premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The variation application is to:
 - i) amend the permitted times for the sale of alcohol to between 6:00 and 23:00, Mondays to Saturdays, Sundays to remain unchanged

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the application for a variation of the premises licence under Section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
 - i. conditions of the current premises licence;
 - ii. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (See appendix 3);
 - iii. conditions recommended by responsible Authorities (see appendix 3);
 - iv. any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

3. Background

3.1 The premises currently holds a licence to:

- i) The premises is currently licensed to sell alcohol between 07:30 and 23:00, Mondays to Sundays.

The applicant has given thought to the potential impact of the grant of this application on the four licensing objectives and considers that the following conditions are appropriate.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

1. The premises shall maintain a CCTV system which gives coverage of all entry and exit points. The system shall continually record whilst the premises are open and conducting licensable activities. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 21 days. Recordings shall be made available upon the receipt of a request by an authorised Officer of the Police or the Local Authority.
2. There shall be "CCTV in Operation" signs prominently displayed at the premises.
3. An incident log (whether kept in a written or electronic form) shall be retained at the premises and made available to an authorised Officer of the Police or the Local Authority.
4. The premises shall operate a proof of age scheme, such as a Challenge 25, whereby the only forms of acceptable identification shall be either a photographic driving licence, a valid passport or any other recognised form of photographic identification incorporating the PASS logo.
5. The premises will be fitted with a burglar alarm system
6. The premises will be fitted with a panic button system for staff to utilise in the case of an emergency.

c) Public safety

The premises licence holder shall ensure that the appropriate fire safety, and health and safety regulations are applied at the premises.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The premises licence holder will endeavour to eliminate or minimise any nuisance arising out of its licensable activities. In doing so the premises licence holder will work with enforcement authorities where any issues are identified. A complaints procedure will be maintained in order that local residents have a means of contact if necessary.

e) The protection of children from harm

1. All staff will receive comprehensive training in relation to age restricted products and in particular the sale of alcohol. No member of staff will be permitted to sell age restricted products until such time as they have successfully completed the aforementioned training.
2. An age till prompt system will be utilised at the premises in respect of age restricted products.
3. A refusals register (whether kept and written or electronic form) will be maintained at the premises and will be made available for inspection upon request by an authorised Officer of the Police or the Local Authority.



Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. The restrictions on hours during which the sale of alcohol is authorised does not prohibit:
 - a) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - b) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
 - c) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
 - d) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military
2. Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container or be consumed in the licensed premises.
3. CCTV system shall be installed and maintained inside and outside the premises, including a CCTV unit, which monitors the immediate vicinity of the premises. All cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and the video recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with time and date stamping. Tape recordings shall be made available to an authorised officer or a police officer with 24 hours of any request.
4. All exit doors shall be maintained easily operable without the use of a key, card, code or similar means.
5. Exit doors shall be regularly checked to ensure that they function satisfactorily. Records of these checks shall be kept and produced on request to the Police and Licensing Authority.
6. Notices detailing the actions to be taken in the event of a fire or other emergency shall be prominently displayed and maintained in a good condition.
7. All fire exits and means of escape shall be signed in accordance with BS5499.
8. All food waste shall be bagged and tied.
9. Waste collection receptacles shall be kept locked.
10. The premises shall enforce a proof of age scheme, which is approved by the authorised officer of the Council and by the Local Police.

11. All staff shall be trained to request proof of age from any persons who looks to be under the age of 18.
12. The licensee, upon receipt of any complaint from the Council or nearby residents with regard to noise or any other disturbance will take immediate action to prevent any reoccurrence of the cause for complaint.

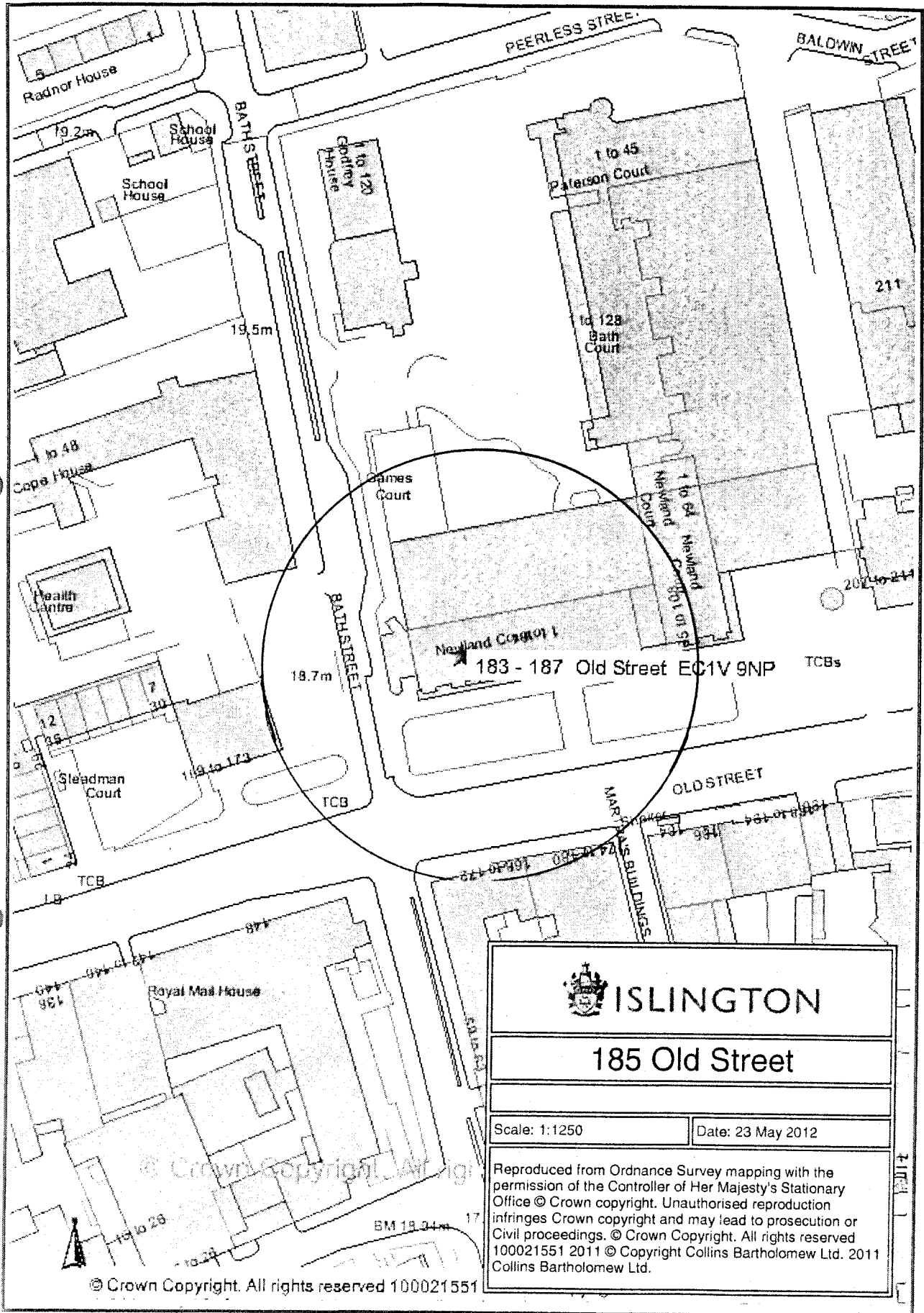

Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule

1. There shall be "CCTV in operation" signs prominently displayed at the premises.
2. An incident log (either in electronic or written form) shall be retained at the premises and made available to an authorised officer of the police or the local authority on request.
3. The premises shall operate a proof of age scheme, such as Challenge 25, whereby the only forms of acceptable identification shall be either a photographic driving licence, a valid passport or any other recognised form of photographic identification incorporating the PASS logo.
4. The premises shall be fitted with a burglar alarm system.
5. The premises shall be fitted with a panic button system for staff to utilise in the case of an emergency.
6. The licensee shall ensure that the appropriate fire safety and health and safety regulations are applied at the premises..
7. The premises licence holder shall endeavour to eliminate or minimise any nuisance arising out of its licensable activities. In doing so the premises licence holder will work with enforcement authorities where any issues are identified. A complaints procedure will be maintained in order that local residents have a means of contact if necessary.
