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**Subject: PREMISES LICENCE VARIATION APPLICATION**  
**RE: DAILY NEWSAGENTS, 61 NEWINGTON GREEN ROAD, LONDON, N1 4QU**

**1. Synopsis**

- 1.1 This is an application for the variation of a premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The variation application is to:
  - i) Apply for an extension of the permitted hours for the sale of alcohol which is currently till 23:00 hrs, to 03:00hrs, Monday to Sunday, off sales only.

**2. Recommendations**

- 2.1 To determine the application for a variation of the premises licence under Section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
  - i. conditions of the current premises licence;
  - ii. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (See appendix 3);
  - iii. conditions recommended by responsible Authorities (see appendix 3);
  - iv. any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

**3. Background**

A new licence was granted to applicant as previous licence had lapsed. New licence granted 27<sup>th</sup> July 2011.

- 3.1 The premises currently holds a licence to:
  - i) The sale by retail of alcohol from 08:00hrs to 23:00hrs, Monday to Sunday, off sales only.
- 3.2 Papers are attached as follows:-
  - Appendix 1: application form;
  - Appendix 2a: name & address details of those persons making representations;
  - Appendix 2: representations;
  - Appendix 3: suggested conditions and map of premise location.
  - Appendix 4 current licence
- 3.3 The Licensing Authority has received 1 letter of representation, however the letter is attached to a petition with 13 addition names.



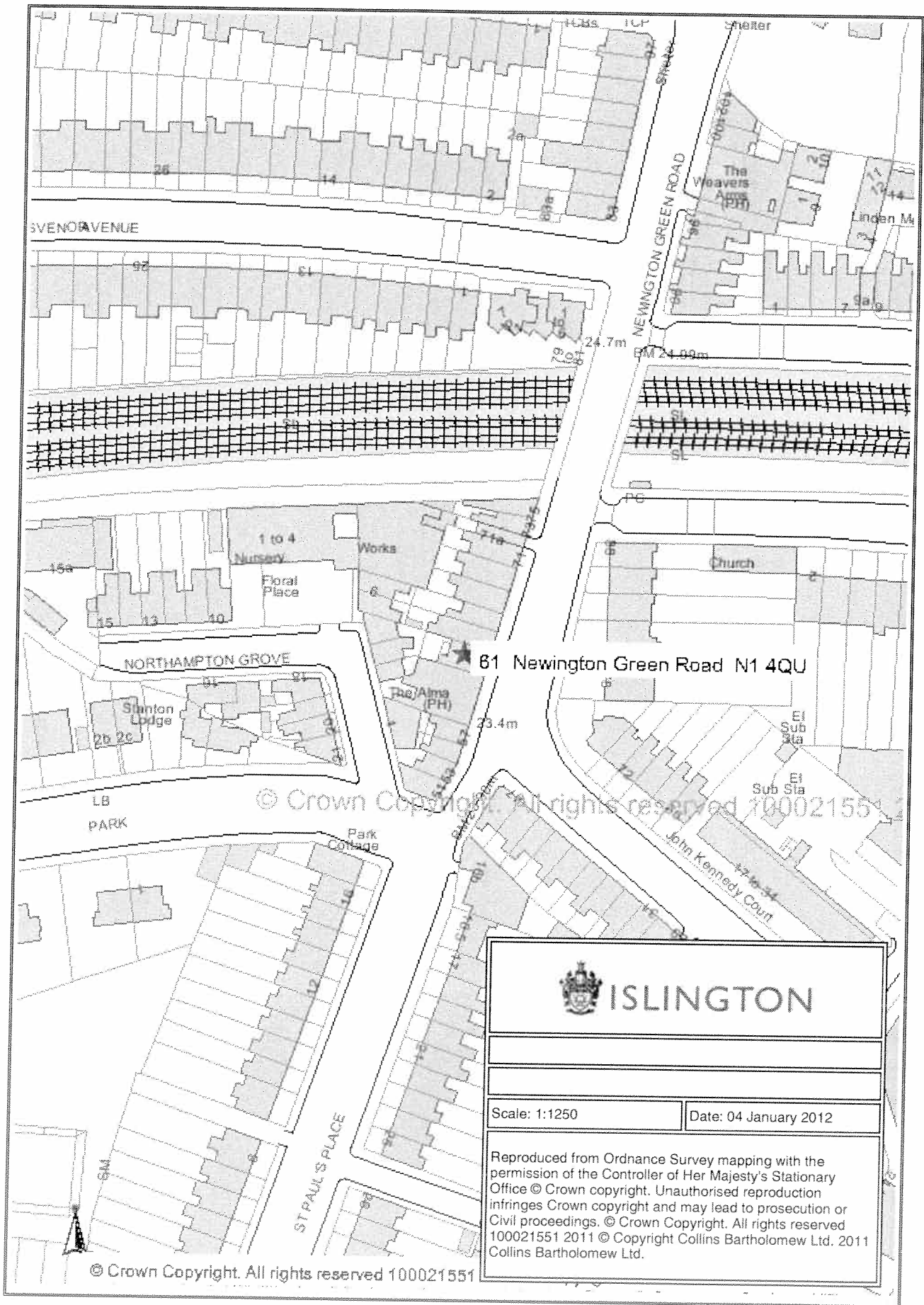

## **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
  - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. All door supervisors shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
4. The admission of children to the exhibition of a film shall be restricted in accordance with the recommendation of a film classification body as defined in the Video Recordings Act 1984 or Islington Council acting as the licensing authority where it has given notice in section 20(3) of the Licensing Act 2003
5. The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
6. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without the assistance by reason of a disability)
7. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
8. The responsible person shall ensure that a proof of age policy is in place.
9. The responsible person shall ensure that the following measures are available, and advertised:
  - a) beer or cider ½ pints;
  - b) gin, rum, vodka or whisky 25ml or 35ml; and
  - c) still wine in a glass 125ml.

## **Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

- 1) Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container or be consumed in the licensed premises
- 2) The fire safety equipment at the premises shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the London Fire Brigade.
- 3) All fire escapes/escape routes shall be clearly marked and kept free from obstructions at all times.
- 4) Customers will be discouraged from congregating outside the premises.
- 5) At least 2 members of staff will be on the shop floor between 23.00 – 07.00 hrs.
- 6) High value goods, expensive wines and spirits to be displayed behind the counter.
- 7) Premises shall be well lit both inside and out to deter offenders and support the CCTV (subject to any planning constraints)
- 8) An alarm system that meets a minimum standard of BSEN50131 grade 1 must be installed at the premises. A panic button facility must be provided at the counter.
- 9) CCTV shall be installed, operated and maintained in agreement with the Police. The system will enable a frontal head and shoulders image of every person entering the

premises. The system shall record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days. Recordings shall be made available to an Authorised Officer or a Police Officer (subject to the Data Protection Act 1998) within 24 hours of any request.

- 10) There shall be no deliveries or loading or unloading of vehicles between 8pm and 8am, Mondays to Saturdays, and no deliveries on Sundays or Bank Holidays.
- 11) There shall be no waste collections between 8pm and 8am, Mondays to Saturdays, and no waste collections on Sundays or Bank Holidays.
- 12) Signs will be installed to remind customers to respect neighbours and leave quietly.
- 13) When the premises are open to the public the sliding entrance/exit door shall be secured in the fully open position.
- 14) The licensee shall adopt the Challenge 25, the Retail of Alcohol Standards Group's advice for off-licences.
- 15) The licensee shall put arrangements in place to ensure that when staff are dealing with young people, they ask for valid photo proof of age, for example a Portman Proof of Age card, a passport or photo style driving licence before selling alcohol to them.
- 16) The licensee shall ensure that staff are trained about age restriction products and ensure that they sign to confirm that they have understood the training. The licensee shall keep records of training and instruction given to staff.
- 17) The licensee shall put arrangements in place to ensure that before serving alcohol to young persons, staff ask to see accredited proof of age cards for example proof of age cards carrying the "PASS" logo (and no others), a passport, or UK Driving Licence bearing the photograph and date of birth of the bearer.
- 18) A notice will be displayed at the till to remind staff to ask for identification.
- 19) The licensee shall require staff to note any refusals to sell to young people in a refusals log. The refusals log shall be checked and signed monthly by the designated premises supervisor. The refusals log shall be made available for inspection by the licensing team, police or trading standards.
- 20) No alcoholic goods will ever be purchased from sellers calling to the shop.
- 21) The licensee will immediately report to Trading Standards any instance of a caller to the shop attempting to sell alcohol.
- 22) Invoices (or copies) for all alcoholic goods on the premises will be kept at the shop and made available to officers from the council, police or HMRC upon request.
- 23) A stock control system will be introduced, so that the licensee can quickly identify where and when alcoholic goods have been purchased.
- 24) An ultra-violet light will be available at the premises for the purpose of checking the UK Duty Stamp on spirits as soon as practical after they have been purchased.
- 25) If any spirits bought by the company have UK Duty Stamps that do not fluoresce under ultra-violet light, or are otherwise suspicious, the licensee shall identify the supplier to Islington Trading Standards and HMRC as soon as possible.
