



### 1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is an application for a new premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The new application is for:
  - i) Late night refreshment from 23:00 to 04:00 Sunday to Thursday and 23:00 to 05:00 Friday and Saturday.

### 2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the application for a new premises licence under Section 19 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
  - i) conditions of the current premises licence;
  - ii) conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule
  - iii) conditions recommended by responsible Authorities
  - iv) any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

#### **Background** 3.

- 3.1 The premises was previously licensed for the provision of late night refreshment from 23:00 to 04:00 Sunday to Thursday and 23:00 to 05:00 Friday and Saturday. The previous licenced lapsed in June 2009 when the company that held the licence was dissolved.





With reference to the above application, I am writing to inform you that the Metropolitan Police, as a Responsible Authority, will be objecting to this application as it is our belief that if granted the application would undermine the Licensing Objectives.

The venue is situated just outside the 'Kings Cross Cumulative impact zone', and although outside it is so close that it cannot fail to have an impact in this locality which is traditionally suffers from high levels crime and disorder and there are concerns that this application will cause further policing problems in an already demanding area.

It is for these reasons that we are objecting to the application and propose that it is refused.

I wish to strongly object to the above license application on the following grounds:

**Nuisance** 

The back of their premises is actually the front entrance of our homes. This is already hugely incompatible. There is a nuisance caused by present customers blocking our entrance to the flats with their cars. Also customers frequently park their cars in Kings Court in residents spaces.

There is a great deal of litter caused by customers eating their food in their cars and throwing their litter on the ground. Sometimes customers like to sit in the residents private garden and picnic with their kebabs

Late night

It is very disconcerting and intimidating to come home after dark and have people standing around the gate to our garden and therefore the entrance to the flats. Customers are sometimes drunk and have used the side of the wall as a toilet. We do not want people to be coming and going further into the night. This will cause further nuisance.

Noise

Noise "bounces" in a natural echo chamber between Kings Court and the backs of the houses in Caledonian Road. This would be exacerbated by the late licence.

Need to keep our gates closed.

We have been advised by the police to keep our gates closed to protect our privacy and to prevent groups of people hanging inside our garden. The kebab shop activities make it very difficult to keep our gates closed.

Kebab shops extension

The first floor extension at the back of the kebab shop housing these premises was illegally constructed by the previous owners who knocked our garden wall down and built out at the back. They put a skip in the car park without permission. After having retrospective planning permission turned down twice, it was eventually awarded to their successors. It has always been a concern that this extension would be used for a late night bar.

In addition they are allowed to use their back entrance leading onto Kings Court for emergency only. However they daily use the exit to push their rubbish to the front of our gates.

Late night drinking premises next to Kings Court will be to the detriment of the residents rights.

#### **Recommendation and Reasons**

The premises is located just outside the Kings Cross Cumulative Impact Area and therefore there is no presumption of refusal in respect of this application

The Licensing Authority has considered the style and hours of operation proposed by the applicant and the management arrangements described in the operating schedule and it is concerned that the late night activities will have an adverse impact on local residents in terms of noise, disturbance and antisocial behaviour.

The Licensing Authority is of the view that the Operating Schedule is not adequate for a late night venue and additional control measures need to implemented to promote the licensing objectives.

In order to minimise the likelihood of the premises adding to the existing cumulative impact the Licensing Authority recommends:

- 1. Late night refreshment ceases at
  - a. 1am on Fridays and Saturdays
  - b. Midnight Sundays to Thursdays
- 2. The following conditions are attached to the licence
  - a. At least two members of staff shall be on the premises after 23.00 until closing time.
  - b. The Licensee shall be responsible for keeping the immediate area outside the shop clean and clear of any litter.
  - c. An externally sited litter bin will be provided at and will be emptied as and when necessary.
  - d. The Licensee shall endeavour to encouraged to disperse quietly from the area
  - e. Appropriately worded notices to be displayed prominently inside and outside the shop requesting customers to leave the site quietly at night respecting local residents
  - f. A contact telephone number for an appropriately authorised duty manager shall be prominently displayed so it can be viewed without the necessity of entering the premises.

- g. There shall be no public seating outside the premises when licensable activities are taking place
- h. CCTV shall be operated in and around the premises.

### Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule

1. All staff shall be trained in public nuisance, health and safety and on the prevention of underage sales.

### Suggested conditions of approval from the Noise Team (accepted)

- 2. No rubbish will be moved, removed or placed in bins outside the premises on Sundays or Bank Holidays nor between the hours of 23:00 and 07:00 hours on any other days of the week.
- 3. Premises users shall be permitted to smoke immediately outside the front of the premises but this shall be restricted to a reasonable number at all times.
- 4. Tables and chairs shall be restricted to the area immediately to the front of the premises and will be restricted to the hours of 11:00 and 19:00. They will be rendered usable and cleared at 19:00.
- 5. The Premises Licence Holder or nominated person shall erect and maintain, in a prominent position at the premises exit a clear, conspicuous and legible notice requesting patrons to avoid causing noise, nuisance or disturbance to local residents.
- 6. No noise or vibration shall be allowed to emanate from the premises fixed plant so as to cause noise disturbance to nearby properties.

- 8. The Licensee shall be responsible for keeping the immediate area outside the shop clean and clear of any litter.

- 10. The Licensee shall endeavour to encouraged to disperse quietly from the area
- 11. Appropriately worded notices to be displayed prominently inside and outside the shop requesting customers to leave the site quietly at night respecting local residents
- 12. A contact telephone number for an appropriately authorised duty manager shall be prominently displayed so it can be viewed without the necessity of entering the premises.
- 13. There shall be no public seating outside the premises when licensable activities are taking place
- 14. CCTV shall be installed, operated and maintained in agreement with the Police. The system will enable frontal identification of every person entering the premises. The system shall record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days. Recordings shall be made available to an Authorised Officer or a Police Officer (subject to the Data Protection Act 1998) within 24 hours of any request.
