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Subject: PREMISES LICENCE NEW APPLICATION
RE: TESCO, 272 –280 NEW NORTH ROAD, LONDON, N1 8SY

1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is an application for a new premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The new application is to:
 - i) Permit the sale of alcohol, off supplies from 06:00 till 23:00 Monday to Sunday.
 - ii) Opening hours of 06:00 till 23:00 seven days a week.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the application for a new premises licence under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
 - i. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (See appendix 3);
 - ii. conditions recommended by responsible Authorities (see appendix 3);
 - iii. any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

3. Background

3.1 Papers are attached as follows:-

- Appendix 1: application form;
- Appendix 2a: name & address details of those persons making representations;
- Appendix 2: representations;
- Appendix 3a existing licence for the premises
- Appendix 3: suggested conditions and map of premise location.

3.2 The Licensing Authority has received 3 letters of representation, none of which are from people who requested that they remain anonymous. The representations come from the trading standards, the noise team and the health & safety officer. One representation was received from a local business but this was invalid.

4. Planning implications

4.1 The Planning Service has reported that there is 1 restrictive condition.

Condition 8

Any A3 use shall not operate except between the hours of 7.30am and 11.00 pm on any day.

REASON: To ensure that the proposed development does not prejudice the enjoyment by neighbouring occupiers of their premises.

5 Conclusion and reasons for recommendations

5.1 The Council is required to consider this application in the light of all relevant information, and if approval is given, it may attach such conditions necessary to promote the licensing objectives.

We are a national retailer that sells alcohol as part of a broad offering of goods and services. We have held off-licences in our stores for many years and are an approved British Institute of Inn-keeping examination centre. We have written training policies and formal training programmes are in place, which ensure our people are equipped to meet all licensing objectives. All training and revision/refresher materials are reviewed regularly. All stores currently comply with our 'Think 25' policy, this is brought to customer's attention through point of sale material within the store. We take legal compliance very seriously and in addition to local training we employ a central alcohol licensing compliance manager and have a compliance committee.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises will have digital CCTV system that covers many areas of the shop floor, including the proposed area which will be used for beer and wine, should we be successful with our application.
Images will be retained for a minimum of 21 days and made available on enforcement request.
Ordinarily, a member of the Management team will be on the premises all the time the store is open. A person will have responsibility for the premises whilst the premises are open.

c) Public safety

A person will have responsibility for the premises whilst the premises are open. Management will be trained to support the running of the premises including looking after our customers and staff. The store will adhere to all rules and regulations relating to public safety.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

We intend to be an active member of the community.
We welcome the opportunity to liaise with Police and enforcement authorities should the need arise.

e) The protection of children from harm

All staff will be trained and regularly refreshed in the corporate 'Think 25' Policy. Staff will be trained to look at the customer and 'Think 25' when selling alcohol.

A till prompt will appear on the initial sale of alcohol that will remind the seller of their responsibilities including not to sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 18.

The store will display signage around the premises informing both staff and customers of our 'Think 25' policy on alcohol.

LICENSING ACT 2003: REPRESENTATIONS BY RESPONSIBLE AUTHORITY

Tesco Stores Ltd., 272-280 New North Road, N1 8SY

The application for a licence for the above premises has been examined by me on behalf of the Trading Standards Section. I wish to make the following representations, relating to the protection of children from harm objective.

1. In the last 18 months, this service has been concerned with the failure rate across Tesco stores during underage test purchasing operations.
2. Tesco training regime with regard to underage sales is believed to be a good system, on paper, with clear instruction, refresher training and testing to ensure that staff understand the training they have just been given.
3. Tesco also uses till prompts that remind staff to ask for proof of age when a young person wishes to buy age-restricted goods. There is always prominent signage in store to indicate that the 'Challenge 25' rule is in use.
4. It is not altogether clear why Tesco have a high sale rate. However, the statistics indicate to me that there is an underlying problem. Whether it is a lack of focus exhibited by branch management, or insufficient insistence by the company that branch management promote the issue to their staff in their normal day-to-day work or some other cause, I believe that further licence conditions are necessary to promote the licensing objectives.
5. I am not seeking the refusal of this application, but I offer these suggested conditions for the consideration of the Licensing Sub-Committee.
 - All individuals in the Management team (persons acting as Duty Managers and above) at the branch shall be personal licence holders.
 - No alcohol sales shall take place except when the Designated Premises Supervisor or another personal licence holder is working on the shop floor.
 - Any person acting as a 'Duty Manager' will have an explicit responsibility for promoting the licensing objectives amongst branch staff, particularly the objective of protecting children from harm.
 - All staff should receive their routine training on age-restricted goods and other licensing matters from the DPS or, in his absence, another personal licence holder.

- The company will organise as least one unannounced test purchase of alcohol by a young person, aged between 18 & 22 every calendar month. The results will be made available to Trading Standards upon request and will detail the date and time of the test, the member of staff involved in the transaction, the age and a photograph of the test purchaser, and details of follow-up work after any sale made.

6. I would welcome Tesco's comments on the proposed conditions prior to the matter being heard at Committee. If we can reach agreement, I would be pleased to withdraw these representations.

I believe these representations are specific and proportionate to the known trading characteristics of this retail sector and are consistent with the Islington Council Statement of Licensing Policies 28 and 32.

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1) The restrictions on hours during which the sale of alcohol is authorised does not prohibit:
 - a) during the first 20 minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - b) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of alcohol so ordered;
 - c) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
 - d) the sale of supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval military.
- 2) Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container or be consumed in the licensed premises
