1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is an application for the variation of a premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The variation application is to:
 - i) Extend the sale of alcohol off the premises only from Monday to Sunday from 23:00 until 00:00;

- 2.1 To determine the application for a variation of the premises licence under Section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
 - i. conditions of the current premises licence;
 - ii. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (See appendix 3);
 - iii. conditions recommended by responsible Authorities (see appendix 3);
 - iv. any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

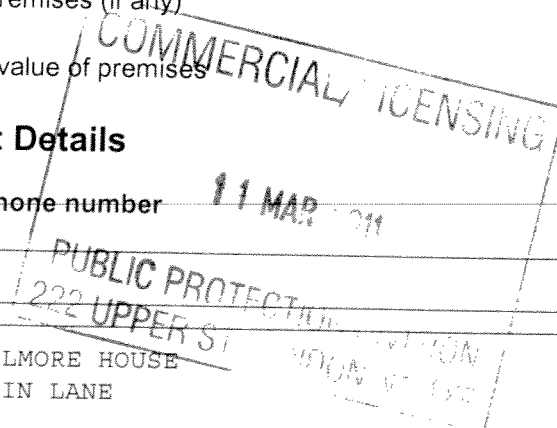

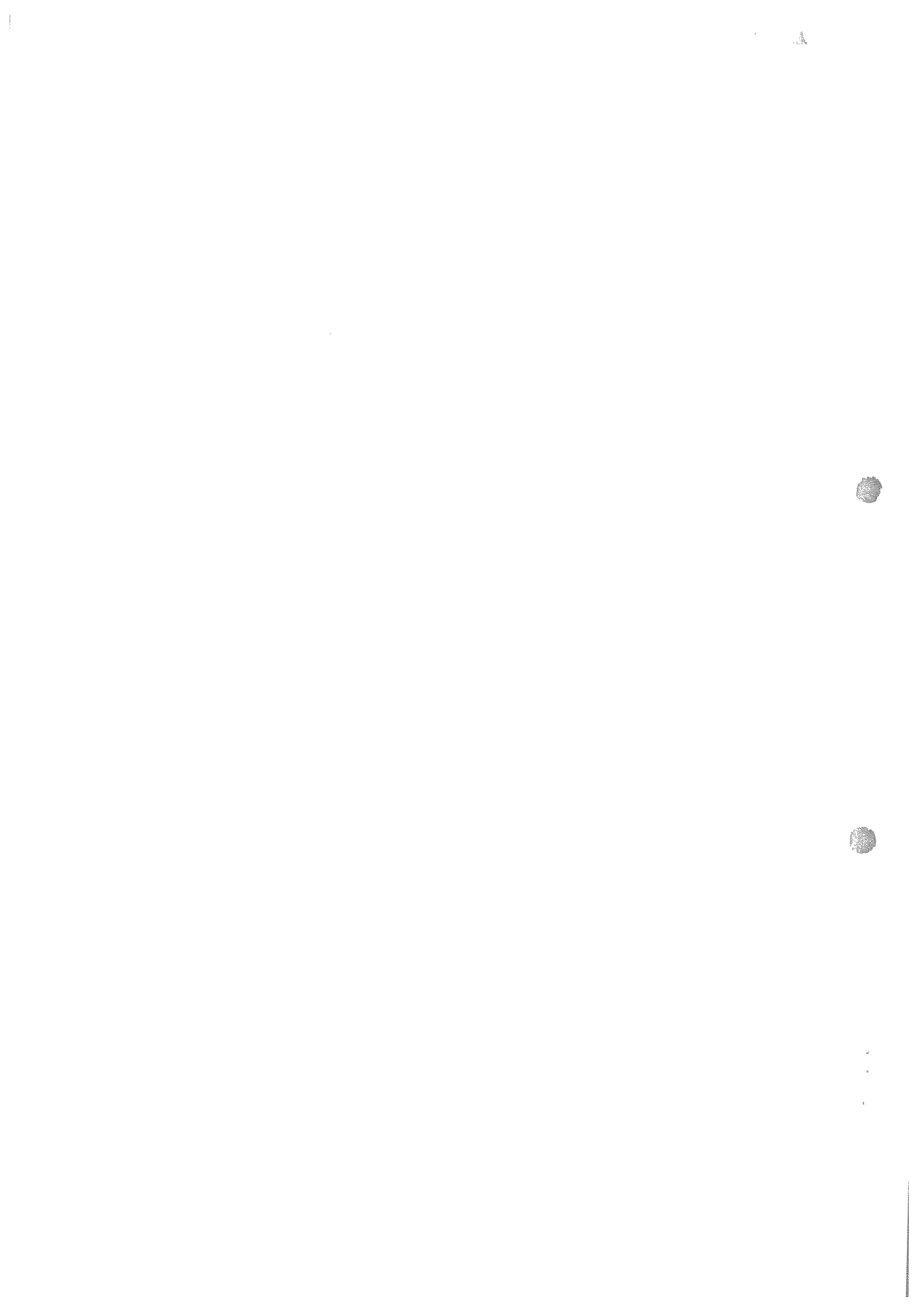

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
4. The responsible person shall ensure that a proof of age policy is in place.

Thank you for notifying me of an application by Morrisons to vary the licence to sell alcohol at their premises.

I live directly opposite the entrance to their premises in Hertslet Road as you will see from my address. My complaint is that there is a group of drunks who congregate outside the supermarket most days. They have obviously bought drinks at the supermarket and use the steps of the supermarket building as a meeting and drinking place. They frequently shout abuse at passers by. They shout at one another and generally cause a nuisance. They have shouted abuse at me also. Last week one of the men decided to stand in the middle of the road in front of my car as I was trying to enter my parking bay (I am a disabled driver with a parking bay just opposite the supermarket). He was threatening and aggressive. They also sleep on the steps and foul them.

I do not see the point of the variation by one hour from 11pm to 12pm. However, I would not agree with this variation until this issue is resolved. A possible solution is for Morrisons to erect a gate to prevent the drunks from occupying the steps.

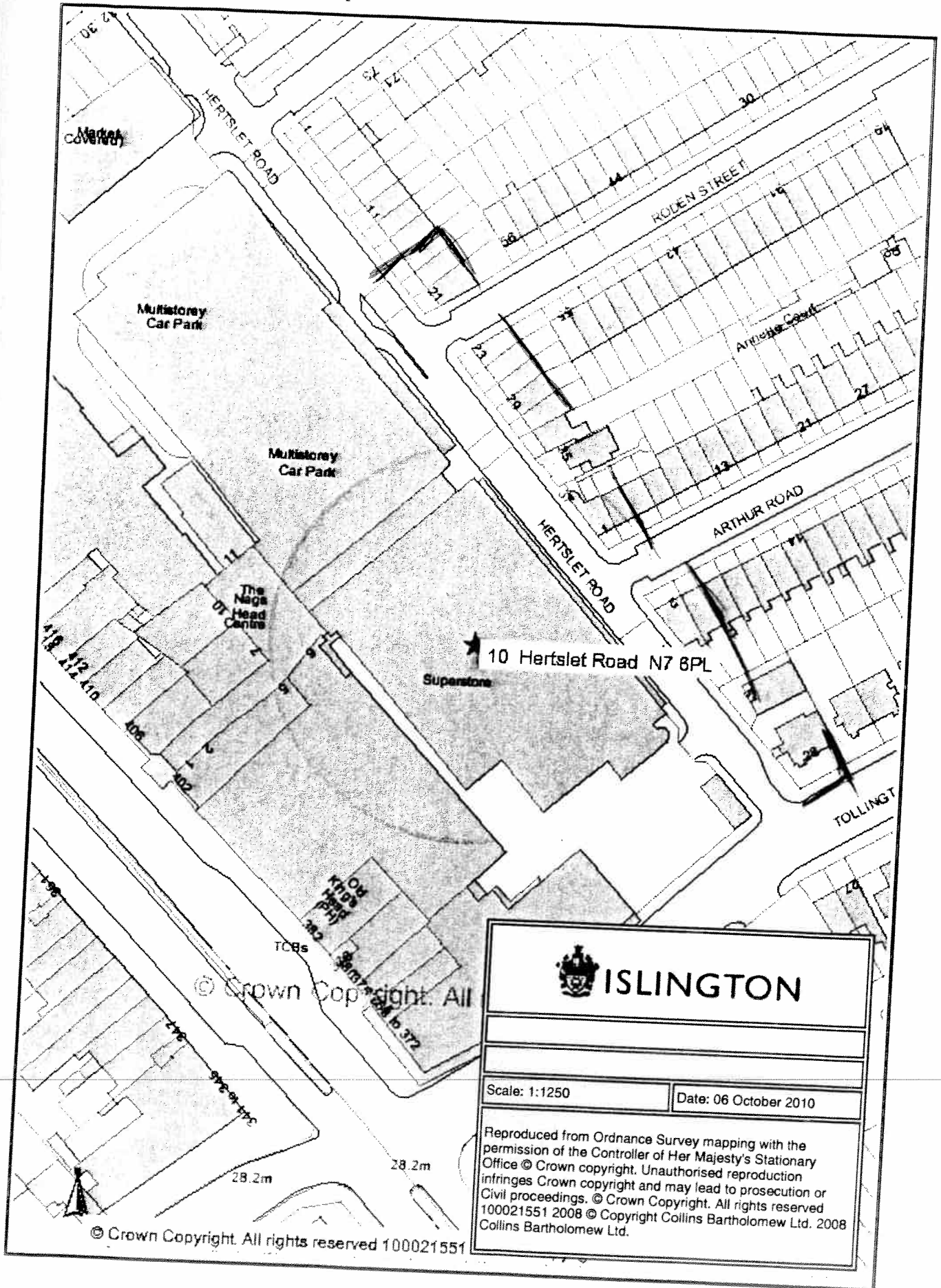
In any case this is a matter not just for Morrisons but for public order and I would like to see action taken to put it right.
