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Subject: PREMISES LICENCE VARIATION APPLICATION
RE: SAINSBURYS, 643 – 645 HOLLOWAY ROAD, LONDON, N19 5SS

1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is an application for the variation of a premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The variation application is to:
 - i) Allow the supply of alcohol, off sales only, Mondays to Sundays from 06:00 until 00:00; and to
 - ii) Remove the embedded restrictions and conditions in Annex 2 of the current premises licence, see conditions 1 and 2.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the application for a variation of the premises licence under Section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
 - i. conditions of the current premises licence;
 - ii. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (See appendix 4);
 - iii. conditions recommended by responsible Authorities (see appendix 4);
 - iv. any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

3. Background

3.1 The premises currently holds a licence to:

- i) The sale of alcohol from 07:00hrs to 23:00hrs, Monday to Sunday, off sales only.

- Appendix 4: suggested conditions and map of premise location.

3.3 The Licensing Authority has received 1 letter of representation, this person has requested that they remain anonymous.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

1. The licence holder will ensure that the premises benefit from a CCTV system that operates at all times when licensable activities are taking place.
2. The system will incorporate a camera covering each of the entrance doors and the main alcohol display area and will be capable of providing an image which is regarded as identification standard. The precise positions of the cameras may be agreed, subject to compliance with Data Protection legislation, with the police from time to time.
3. The system will incorporate a recording facility and any recording will be retained and stored in a suitable and secure manner for a minimum of 30 days and will be made available, subject to compliance with Data Protection legislation, to the police for inspection on request.
4. The system must be able to export recorded images to a removable means e.g. CD/DVD and have its own software enabled to allow playback/review.
5. A member of staff trained in the use of the CCTV system must be available at the premises at all times that the premises are open to the public.
6. The system will display, on any recording, the correct time and date of the recording.

c) Public safety

The applicant will at all times maintain adequate levels of staff and security. Such staff and security levels will be disclosed, on request, to the licensing authority and police.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Signage will be displayed at the exit of the premises requesting customers leaving the premises late at night to do so quietly and with consideration so as not to disturb nearby residents.

e) The protection of children from harm

1. The premises licence holder will ensure that an age verification policy will apply to the premises whereby all cashiers will be trained to ask any customer attempting to purchase alcohol, who appears to be under the age of 25 years (or older if the licence holder so elects) to produce (before being sold alcohol) identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

2. All sales tills shall prompt the cashier making a sale of alcohol to verify that the customer is aged 18 or over.



Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. The restrictions on hours during which the sale of alcohol is authorised does not prohibit:
 - a) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - b) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
 - c) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
 - d) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military
2. Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container or be consumed in the licensed premises
3. A CCTV system shall be installed and maintained inside and inside the premises, including a CCTV unit, which monitors the immediate vicinity of the premises. All cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and the recording shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with time and date stamping. Recordings shall be made available to an authorised officer or a police officer within 24 hours of any request.
4. Notices shall be prominently displayed at exits requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
5. All cashiers will be trained and monitored to require evidence of age from any person seeking to buy alcohol and appearing to the cashier to be under the age of 18. Records shall be kept of such training. This required evidence shall be photographic, such as passport or photographic driving licence until other effective identification technology (for example thumb print or pupil recognition) is introduced.
6. Prominent notices shall be displayed at points of sale advising customers that they may be asked to provide evidence of age.
7. In premises where items are scanned at the till, bar codes shall be used on age restricted goods to activate till a prompt to alert staff to check the age of the purchaser.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

I am writing regarding the application from Sainsbury's of 643-645 Holloway Road to apply to sell alcohol from 6.00am rather than 7.00am and to extend it to 00.00 rather than 11.00pm.

Firstly I would like to raise the point that this extension, will, in turn cause more people to consume the alcohol on the street outside the store. I have personally seen people go in the store and come out after purchasing alcohol of which they drink on the corner of Hargrave Road and Holloway road. These people continue to drink until they are inebriated and cause a public disturbance, threatening and intimidating passers by. There seem to be groups of people in the immediate area that consume a lot of alcohol to the point of being a disturbance and the extension will exacerbate the problem.

Drunk people already tend to urinate on the end of Hargrave Road and I am concerned that further easy access to alcohol will cause a further disturbance.

There are often Sainsbury's carrier bags with empty strong lager bags in left on the pavement.

Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule

1. The licence holder will ensure that the premises benefit from a CCTV system that operates at all times when licensable activities are taking place.
2. The CCTV system:
 - a) will incorporate a camera covering each of the entrance doors and the main alcohol display area and will be capable of providing an image which is regarded as identification standard. The precise positions of the cameras may be agreed, subject to compliance with Data Protection legislation, with the Police from time to time;
 - b) will incorporate a recording facility and any recording will be retained and stored in a suitable and secure manner for a minimum of 30 days and will be made available, subject to compliance with Data Protection legislation, to the Police for inspection on request;
 - c) must be able to export recorded images to a removable means e.g. CD/DVD and have it's own software enabled to allow playback/review; and
 - d) will display, on any recording, the correct time and date of the recording.
3. A member of staff trained in the use of the CCTV system must be available at the premises at all times that the premises are open to the public.
4. The licence holder will at all times maintain adequate levels of staff and security. Such staff and security levels will be disclosed, on request, to the Licensing Authority and Police on request.
5. Signage will be displayed at the exit of the premises requesting customers leaving the premises late at night to do so quietly and with consideration so as not to disturb nearby residents.
6. The premises licence holder will ensure that an age verification policy will apply to the premises whereby all cashiers will be trained to ask any customer attempting to purchase alcohol, who appears to be under the age of 25 years (or older if the licence holder so elects) to produce (before being sold alcohol) identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
7. All sales tills shall prompt the cashier making a sale of alcohol to verify that the customer is aged 18 or over.

8. No alcohol products/packaging shall be placed into outdoor refuse storage facilities between the hours of 11pm and 7am.
