PREMISES LICENCE NEW APPLICATION

RE: 100 Old Street, London EC1V 9AY

1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is an application for a new premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The new application is to:
 - i) Supply alcohol on the premises from Monday to Sunday from 10:00 to 23:00;

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the application for a new premises licence under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 To consider the representation from the Police in the light of the revised Secretary of State Guidance to Local Authorities issued on 25th April 2012 namely:

The Licensing Authority should accept all reasonable and proportionate representations made by the Police unless the Authority has evidence that to do so would not be appropriate for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.

- 2.3 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
 - i) conditions of the current premises licence;
 - ii) conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule
 - iii) conditions recommended by responsible Authorities

iv) any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

- 3.2 The Licensing Authority has received 1 letter of representation from the Police.
- 3.3 Licence history at the premises:
 - i. The premises has never held a licence for the sale of alcohol
 - ii. Until recently the ground floor of the premises was a licensed sex shop.

4. Planning Implications

4.1 The lawful use of this property appears to be retail (A1). The use of the basement as a bar or other type of drinking establishment would require planning permission. The owner has spoken to Planning and is aware that planning consent is required

5. Conclusion and reasons for recommendations

5.1 The Council is required to consider this application in the light of all relevant information, and if approval is given, it may attach such conditions necessary to promote the licensing objectives.





The application for a new premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003 for the above premises has been examined and the following representations are made in pursuance of the prevention of crime and disorder element of the LA 2003: -

The sale of Alcohol to be ancillary to the sale of food.

Alcohol consumption to be confined to basement area only.

No vertical drinking.

A digital CCTV system shall be installed, operated and maintained inside and outside the premises [subject to planning permission] in agreement with the Police. The system will enable a frontal head and shoulders image of every person entering the premises. The system shall record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days. A working copy shall be supplied free of charge to a Police Officer within 24 hours of any request to assist in the investigation of a crime or apprehending or prosecuting an offender. It is the responsibility of the premise to download any recording requests.

Police believe that these representations are relevant and proportionate to the licence application, and would wish to see them as conditions on the licence should it be granted.

Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule

- 1. All instances of crime and disorder shall be reported to the police.
- 2. The holder of the premises licence shall subscribe to and participate fully in the local pub/club/shop watch scheme.
- 3. The premises shall not be used under the licence until the means of escape and general arrangements at the premises are suitable and sufficient for health and public safety and have been approved in writing by the responsible authority for health and public safety.
- 4. The premises shall not be used under the licence until copies of the inspection and test certificates specified below, properly certified by approved competent persons, have been submitted to the council and have been approved in writing by the responsible authority for health and public safety.
- 5. Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 6. The licensee shall adopt the Challenge 25 and the Bil National Standards Proof of Age Scheme.
- 7. Alcohol consumption to be confined to basement area only.
- 8. A digital CCTV system shall be installed, operated and maintained inside and outside the premises [subject to planning permission] in agreement with the Police. The system will enable a frontal head and shoulders image of every person entering the premises. The system shall record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days. A working copy shall be supplied free of charge to a Police Officer within 24 hours of any request to assist in the investigation of a crime or apprehending or prosecuting an offender. It is the responsibility of the premise to download any recording requests.

Suggested conditions of approval recommended by the Police

- 9. The sale of Alcohol to be ancillary to the sale of food.
- 10. No vertical drinking.
