

TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE APPLICATION

RE: FIGARO NEWS, 15 STATION PLACE, LONDON, N4 2DH

1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is a hearing to determine a temporary event notice (TEN) in respect of the above premises to extend the terminal hour for licensable activities from midnight to 6.00am on 1 January 2014 The temporary event notice is applied for under section 100, Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 This application is subject to a representation from the Metropolitan Police in respect of the prevention of crime and disorder.
- 1.3 The Licensing Sub-Committee are asked to consider whether or not to authorise the notice, and if allowed whether to impose any of the current premises licence conditions.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the temporary event notice under Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003 as the Licensing Sub-Committee consider appropriate for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.
- 2.2 The Committee can decide to:
 - i. allow the temporary event notice for the specified event,
 - ii. allow the temporary event, subject to one or more conditions of the existing premises licence:
 - iii. prohibit the temporary event notice by way of a counter notice.

3. Background

- 3.1 The premise holds a premises licence which allows the sale of alcohol for off sales only between 06:00 until 00:00 Monday to Saturday and on Sunday from 07:00 until 22:00.

With reference to the above application, I am writing to inform you that the Metropolitan Police, as a Responsible Authority, will be objecting to this application as it is our belief that if granted the application would undermine the Licensing Objectives.
The venue is situated in the 'Holloway Road and Finsbury Park Cumulative impact area', a locality where there is traditionally high crime and disorder and there are concerns that this application will cause further policing problems in an already demanding area. Although we cannot object based solely on this we have concerns that this event has the potential to cause problems. The event is due to take place in the early hours of new years day and is immediately adjacent to the Finsbury Park over ground and underground station entrances. It is not uncommon for persons to congregate in this area after being out on this night celebrating the new year and not being able to get transport home. We have concerns then that these persons will then buy more alcohol from this premises and continue to drink and become involved in ASB and crime, not necessarily being responsible for committing crime but also becoming the victims of crime due to their consumption of alcohol. These persons will have nowhere to go to drink apart from on the street and Islington Borough has a Designated Public Places Order (DPPO). We believe that making alcohol available to persons in this area will hinder the dispersa of people away from the area leading to a strain on emergency services at a time when their resources will already be stretched to the limit.
It is for these reasons that we are objecting to the application.

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1. All spirits shall be kept behind the counter and in a protective area.
- 2. A noise management plan shall be in place.
- 3. Clear signs shall be displayed requesting customer to leave the premises and area quietly.
- 4. CCTV camera system shall be installed at the premises; this system shall be maintained in full working order whilst the premise is used for licensable activities.
- 5. Any spillages at the premises shall be immediately cleaned away.
- 6. The premises shall enforce a proof of age scheme approved by the Police and the Council.
