Subject: TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE APPLICATIONS
RE: THE WINCHESTER, 2 ESSEX ROAD, LONDON,N1 8LN

1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is a hearing to determine 3 temporary event notices (TEN's) in respect of the above premises to extend the terminal hour for licensable activities for the sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises, regulated entertainment and late night refreshment from 00.00 to 02.00 on 17th, 18th, 19th, 23rd and 24th December 2013. The thirds temporary events notice applies to extend the terminal hour for licensable activities for the sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises, regulated entertainment and late night refreshment from 00.00 to 04.00 on 1st January 2014. The temporary event notice is applied for under section 100, Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 This application is subject to a representation from the Police for crime and disorder.
- 1.3 The Licensing Sub-Committee are asked to consider whether or not to authorise the notice, and if allowed whether to impose any of the current premises licence conditions.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the temporary event notice under Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003 as the Licensing Sub-Committee consider appropriate for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.
- 2.2 The Committee can decide to:
 - i. allow the temporary event notice for the specified event,

- ii. allow the temporary event, subject to one or more conditions of the existing premises licence;
- iii. prohibit the temporary event notice by way of a counter notice.

3. Background

3.1 The premise holds a premises licence which allows regulated entertainment between 09:00 and 00:00 Sunday to Wednesday, 09:00 and 02:00 Thursday and 09:00 to 04:00 Friday and Saturday. The sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises between 11:00 and 00:00 Sunday to Wednesday, 11:00 and 02:00 Thursday and between 11:00 and 03:30 Friday and Saturday. Late night refreshment from 23:00 until 00:30 Sunday to Wednesday and 23:00 to 02:30 Thursday to Saturday.

With reference to the above application, I am writing to inform you that the Metropolitan Police, as a Responsible Authority, will be objecting to this application as it is our belief that if granted the application would undermine the Licensing Objectives.

The venue is situated in the 'Angel & Upper Street Cumulative impact area', a locality where there is traditionally high crime and disorder and there are concerns that this application will cause further policing problems in an already demanding area. Although we cannot object based solely on this we have concerns that this event has the potential to cause problems. The events are due to take place in the early hours between 0000 - 0200hrs and 0000-0400hrs. The crime levels at the premises, although not excessively high, show a trend, that being that of the 21 reported crimes at the venue in the last year, 17 occurred after midnight. Of these offences 16 are thefts, 2 x GBH, 1 x ABH and 2 x Common assaults. All but one of the violent crimes occurred after midnight and in fact one of the GBH offences occurred at 0135hrs on the 1st January 2013, the corresponding date to one of the dates requested on this application. The other violent crime occurred at 2320hrs. It would seem from these figures that the venue appears to attract late night crime and it is at these times that the emergency services are under the most strain.

We also note that the nights on which these events are requested are a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, days when the sale of alcohol would normally cease at Midnight. We feel that the venue needs to deal effectively with the problems it is and has experienced before being allowed to sell alcohol for extended periods with the potential of even more issues.

It is for these reasons that we are objecting to the application.



Regarding our request to open The Winchester later on stated days, we would like to provide some additional information which we feel would appease any concerns the police may have.

Over the last year, the Winchester team has been highly dedicated to keeping crime and theft to an absolute minimum. We have done so by learning from past, negative experiences and drawing from them to put new procedures in place to ensure a safe environment.

The ways in which we have effectively done this are:

- 1] SECURITY - The security patrol inside and outside the venue, ensuring noise control and safety. On the days in question we will be adding extra security to reduce any issues
- 2] CLOAKROOM - We now open it earlier, have signs in the bar and also always inform and encourage customers to use it.
- 3] EXTRA TRAINING FOR STAFF - We have taken time to make sure our staffs have a good grasp of how to handle difficult situations regarding refusal of sale of alcohol to someone who has had too much, and monitoring how much people have had to drink and whether they may be getting close to having too much.
- 4] HEAD OF SECURITY - Our head of security ensures all people are searched upon arrival and that known trouble makers never re-enter the venue
- 5] AS RECOMMENDED TO US BY THE COUNCIL we serve only in plastic glass in late night evening shifts to eliminate any problems in that area
- 6] CHELSEA CLIPS are fitted on every table
- 7] WATER is readily available for customers and is regularly recommended
- 8] AS RECOMMENDED TO US BY THE COUNCIL half an hour before closing we stop serving and the lights are gradually raised as the music is gradually lowered. This helps the customers leave quietly and sporadically
- 9] DOOR CASHIER- our door cashier as part of his duties patrols and asks customers to keep noise to an absolute minimum.
- 10] CCTV- We have 16 CCTV cameras to maximize safety

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. All door supervisors shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
4. The admission of children to the exhibition of a film shall be restricted in accordance with the recommendation of a film classification body as defined in the Video Recordings Act 1984 or Islington Council acting as the licensing authority where it has given notice in section 20(3) of the Licensing Act 2003.
5. The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any "irresponsible promotions" in relation to the premises.

In this condition, an "irresponsible promotion" means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children:

- a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to:
 - i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
 - c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on:
 - i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
 - e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
6. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
 7. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

8. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

9. The responsible person shall ensure that:
- a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:
 - i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. The sale of alcohol must be ancillary to the use of the premises for music and dancing and substantial refreshment.
2. The licence shall be subject to the Council's standard conditions for Places of Entertainment
3. The licence shall be subject to the Council's technical standards for Places of Entertainment
4. The maximum number of persons accommodated at any one time in the premises shall not exceed the following:
 - a. Basement 100; and
 - b. Ground Floor 100.
5. The licence is subject to the following Additional Conditions referred to in the Standard Conditions for Places of Public Entertainment:
 - i. **ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS D: APPLICABLE TO PREMISES USING DOOR SUPERVISORS.**
 - ii. **ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS SX: FOR PARTICULAR CONTROL OVER STRIPEASE OR SIMILAR ENTERTAINMENT INVOLVING NUDITY.**
 - iii. **ADDITIONAL CONDITION GO: APPLICABLE TO THE KEEPING OF GOOD ORDER.**
6. The inward opening final exit doors specified below shall be locked in the fully open position when the premises are occupied: entrance/exit door at the corner of Essex Road/St Peter's Street and the exit door fronting St Peter's Street.
7. The name and contact telephone number of the persons in charge of the premises shall be displayed on the premises in a prominent position so that it can be seen from the outside of the premises, so that residents have the opportunity to telephone the person in charge if patrons are causing a nuisance.
8. The Licensee shall ensure that at all times that this licence is in operation, all amplified sound and music is subject to the control of an entertainment noise control system set to music noise levels approved by and in conjunction with the Council's Noise team.

9. The entertainment noise control system is to be calibrated and maintained at settings that restrict all amplified sound played at the premises at or below the levels when measured at specified monitoring points as follows:
 - a. Ground Floor
 - b. Measurements taken at a height of 1.5m, facing the DJ booth at 2m distance and 2m from the kitchen in the rear area of the bar.
 - c. 90 dB (Lin) Leq (1 min);
 - d. 84 dB (A) Leq (1 min);
 - e. 74 dB at the 63 Hz Octave Band (1 min); and
 - f. 88 dB at the 125 Hz Octave Band (1 min).
 - g. Basement
 - h. Measurements taken at a height of 1.5 m, facing the rear wall, with back to the DJ booth at 2m from the booth at equal distances from the pillar and the right hand side wall.
 - i. 99.5 (Lin) Leq (1 min);
 - j. 95 dB (A) Leq (1 min);
 - k. 87 dB at the 63 Hz Octave Band (1 min); and
 - l. 96 dB at the 125 Hz Octave Band (1 min)
10. If there are any changes in the distribution and type of loudspeakers or amplification equipment serving the sound system, then the noise control system shall be recalibrated so the music noise levels specified above are not exceeded. The calibration certificate shall be forwarded to the Council's Licensing Team.
11. The entertainment noise control system shall be regularly monitored, checked and its calibration adjusted as necessary so the music noise levels approved by the Council above are not exceeded. On receipt of a noise complaint, independently substantiated by an Islington Council noise off, a calibration certificate from an acoustic consultant shall be submitted detailing the following:
 - a. confirmation that the entertainment noise control system is operating correctly so that the music noise levels above are not being exceeded; and
 - b. the components and make-up of the sound system under the control of the entertainment noise control system.
12. On Thursday, Friday & Saturday SIA registered door staff are to be employed at the premises from 21:00hrs until 30 minutes after the premises closes at the ratio of, at least, 1 door supervisor to every 100 customers. At any other time when a DJ and/or live music is provided, door supervisors shall be employed 30 minutes before the beginning of the event until closing time at a ratio of, at least 1:100. The door supervisor/s shall also be responsible for ensuring the vicinity of the premises is clear of litter attributable to the premises.
13. Noise from the rooftop plant shall not cause an increase in existing background levels at the nearest noise sensitive façade.
14. An attendant shall be on duty in the vicinity of the cloakroom during the whole time it is in use.
15. The premises shall actively participate in the local Pubwatch
16. A digital CCTV system shall be installed, operated and maintained inside and outside the premises [subject to planning permission] in agreement with the Police. The system will enable a frontal head and shoulders image of every person entering the premises. The system shall record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days. A working copy shall be supplied free of charge to a Police Officer within 24 hours of any request to assist in the investigation of a crime or apprehending or

prosecuting an offender. It is the responsibility of the premise to download any recording requests.

17. Incident/Refusals book to be completed and checked weekly by the DPS.
18. Premises to adopt Bill Challenge 25 the National Proof of Age Standards Scheme.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

1. No unaccompanied children shall be allowed in the premises . No children under 16 shall be allowed on the premises after 18:00 with the exception of private functions.
2. That the closing time for the premises will be half an hour after the terminal hour for the sale of alcohol.
3. That notices be displayed reminding people to leave quietly and to use the toilets before leaving.
