Subject: NEW PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION
EMIRATES STADIUM, DRAYTON PARK, LONDON, N5

1. Recommendation

1.1. To adjourn the premise licence application for Emirates Stadium until the 26th June 2013 to enable the planning application to be determined.

2. Synopsis

- 2.1. This is an application for a new premises licence made under the Licensing Act 2003 to permit the above premises to hold up to six live music events within the stadium bowl each year, submitted on 1 March 2013.
- 2.2. This application is subject to representations from the Police, Noise Team, and over 200 local residents.
- 2.3. The premise is also subject to a similar planning application to amend the current restrictions from 3 to up to 6 concerts a year.
- 2.4. Both applications were consulted on concurrently to prevent duplication and confusion. The planning application is being heard by the Planning Sub-Committee on the 18th June 2013.

2.5. The premises licence application should be heard within 28 days of the close of the consultation however the Council's Licensing Policy 6 expects applicants to have the lawful planning consent in place before determining an application. Arsenal wish to abide by this and the Licensing Sub-Committee are therefore asked to adjourn the determination of this application until 26th June 2013.
