	<p><b>*(a) Employment, etc</b> - Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain.</p> <p><b>(b) Sponsorship</b> - Any payment or other financial benefit in respect of your expenses in carrying out duties as a member, or of your election; including from a trade union.</p> <p><b>(c) Contracts</b> - Any current contract for goods, services or works, between you or your partner (or a body in which one of you has a beneficial interest) and the council.</p> <p><b>(d) Land</b> - Any beneficial interest in land which is within the council's area.</p> <p><b>(e) Licences</b>- Any licence to occupy land in the council's area for a month or longer.</p> <p><b>(f) Corporate tenancies</b> - Any tenancy between the council and a body in which you or your partner have a beneficial interest.</p> <p><b>(g) Securities</b> - Any beneficial interest in securities of a body which has a place of business or land in the council's area, if the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body or of any one class of its issued share capital.</p>
