

TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE APPLICATIONS

RE: THE GUNNERS, 204 BLACKSTOCK ROAD, LONDON, N5 1EN

### 1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is a hearing to determine a temporary event notice (TEN) in respect of the above premises for licensable activities from 20:00 to 04:00 on 8/9 November 2014. The temporary event notice is applied for under section 100, Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 This application is subject to a representation from the Council's Noise in respect of public nuisance.
- 1.3 The Licensing Sub-Committee are asked to consider whether or not to authorise the notice, and if allowed whether to impose any of the current premises licence conditions.

#### 2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the temporary event notice under Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003 as the Licensing Sub-Committee consider appropriate for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.
- 2.2 The Committee can decide to:
  - i. allow the temporary event notice for the specified event,
  - ii. allow the temporary event, subject to one or more conditions of the existing premises licence:
  - iii. prohibit the temporary event notice by way of a counter notice.

### 3. Background

- 3.1 The premise holds a premises licence which allows regulated entertainment and sale of alcohol between 12:00 and 00:00 on Monday to Sunday, and late night refreshment from 23:00 until 00:30 Monday to Sunday.
- 3.2 The premises had two late temporary event notices refused by the Noise Team in the last two months

### NOISE NUISANCE FROM AMPLIFIED MUSIC, THE GUNNERS, 204 BLACKSTOCK ROAD, LONDON N5 1EN. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990, LICENSING ACT 2003

We are in receipt of calls from local residents in relation to loud amplified music from the Gunners.

The only relevant noise conditions on the premises licence in relation to noise are as follows:

- Doors and windows to the premises will be kept closed, so far as practicable, at all times
  when noise generating regulated entertainment is taking place i.e. film showing, live and
  recorded music.
- That the beer garden be closed and cleared by 11:20pm

We are concerned that in the event of further noise nuisance being witnessed we may need to take formal enforcement action. This could be by service of a Section 80 noise abatement notice on you and the DPS Mr Hoyle as being the persons responsible for the noise nuisance. In addition an application for a review of the premises licence could be applied for which could result in the licence being modified. Either of these measures could have a serious effect on the business. The effect of a review could be that hours could be reduced and permitted licensable activities such as the provision of entertainments could be curtailed. Contravention of a Section 80 abatement notice is a criminal matter. Current maximum fines for offences are u to £20,000 per offence.

In order to avoid possible enforcement action we are suggesting that the premises management participate in a sound setting exercise with us in order to set maximum music volume at the premises.

This would require the installation of a noise limiter, we would attend by appointment and set maximum sound levels by visiting residents in close vicinity of the premises. These visits take place on Tuesday nights from 22:30 onwards. You would need to appoint an acoustic consultant accredited by the Institute of Acoustics or Association of Noise Consultants in order to source a suitable limiter and set it so that maximum agreed sound levels would not be exceeded.

I have to warn you that in the event of further noise nuisance being witnessed we are minded to move to enforcement action as described above without further warning.

Please contact me within 10 working days to inform me whether you are interested in participating in a sound setting exercise at the premises. I look forward to hearing from you.

### **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
  - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3. All door supervisors shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- 4. The admission of children to the exhibition of a film shall be restricted in accordance with the recommendation of a film classification body as defined in the Video Recordings Act 1984 or Islington Council acting as the licensing authority where it has given notice in section 20(3) of the Licensing Act 2003.

There are further 'Mandatory conditions' applicable to licences authorising the supply of alcohol. A full list of the current mandatory conditions is available from the licensing pages on Islington's web site, <a href="www.islington.gov.uk">www.islington.gov.uk</a>. This list is subject to change by order of the Secretary of State and licensees and other responsible persons are advised to ensure they are aware of the latest conditions.

### Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- The premises shall employ SIA registered door supervisors when Arsenal Football Club are playing home matches. The number of door supervisors employed on match days shall be agreed in writing with both Metropolitan Police and the Licensing Authority prior to the use of this licence.
- Any instances of crime and disorder at the premises shall be reported to the Police immediately, record of these incidents shall be kept in a general incident *log-book* in which are recorded details of each day's events. This log shall be made available to an authorised officer or a police officer with 24 hours of any request.
- A dedicated licensed taxi/mini cab service shall be available with the premises for customers.
- Doors and windows to the premises will be kept closed, so far as practicable, at all times when noise generating regulated entertainment is taking place i.e. film showing, live and recorded music.
- The premises shall enforce a proof of age scheme, which is approved by the Licensing Authority and by the Local Police.
- The provision of making music at the premises shall be limited to Karaoke.

### Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

- No more than 12 extensions per premises per year (excluding applications made under TENS) should be allowed.
- A minimum of 7 days notices in writing to police and the licensing authority.
- 3 An absolute veto for police in respect of any of these occasions.
- Unless otherwise agreed with the Police on days when AFC are playing home matches and between the times commencing four hours before the advertised start of the game and until 1 hour after the game finishes no glass containers should be taken out of the premises.

- On days when Arsenal Football Club are playing home matches the start time for the sale of alcohol should be 10am on Monday to Saturday and 12 midday on Sunday, unless otherwise agreed with the police
- 6 That the beer garden be closed and cleared by 11:20pm
- Notices shall be displayed reminding patrons to use the toilet facilities before leaving the premises.
- There will be no unaccompanied persons under the age of 16 years allowed in the bar at any time. Accompanied persons under the age of 16 years must leave by 21:00. On match days only, no unaccompanied persons under the age of 16 years allowed in the bar at any time except to go through to the toilets accompanied by an adult. Accompanied children to be allowed in the beer garden until 22:00.
