- 3.2 The Police, 1 local resident and 1 local business have submitted representations. The Noise Service did submit a representation with conditions, however these have been agreed by the applicant. The applicant sent a supporting letter to licensing and requested that I forward to the 2 reps, this was done.
- 3.3 Prior to this application the licensing team along with Police officers visited the premises in a joint working operation. The visit took place on 27th February 2013 and was aimed at premises suspected of making illegal gaming machines available for use to be played on their premises. Licensing officers spoke to the manager of the premises and explained that all of the gaming machines that were found were illegally sited, which is an offence under the Gambling Act 2005. The manager was warned that the machines would need to be removed immediately. A follow up visit took place in April 2013 and all the machines had been removed.

4. Planning Implications

4.1 Change of use to a private social club was granted in 1992. The use shall not operate except between the hours of 09:30 and 23:30 on any day.

5 Recommendations

- 5.1 To determine the application for a new premises licence under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 5.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
 - i. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (see appendix 3)
 - ii. any conditions deemed appropriate by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.(see appendix 3)
 - iii. any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

6 Conclusion and reasons for recommendations

6.1 The Council is required to consider this application in the light of all relevant information, and if approval is given, it may attach such conditions as appropriate to promote the licensing objectives.



Dear John,

I have been informed that the Turkish social club called Cengis Place at 47 Green Lanes has applied for a license to sell alcohol from 17:00 to 23:00 Monday to Sunday.

As a local resident who xxxx property if it is possible I would like to register my concern and objection toward this application. Over the last couple of years myself and other local residents have worked with the Council and Police to improve this section of Green Lanes to the benefit of the local residents and businesses, with the aim in developing a vibrant street serving the wider community. As a result we have also formed the Green Lanes xxxx to work together to achieve this objective. Together with the Council and Police we have seen some improvements on the street including the closure of illegal social clubs and are keen to ensure this continued success.

My concerns specifically with 47 Cengis Place are as follows:

- there are a great number of social clubs on this part of Green Lanes, some of which have been closed down due to illegal activity. This sheer volume of clubs is detrimental to the wider community as they are private and have proven to bring in issues of illegal gambling, crime, noise, anti social behaviour, increased traffic, and parking violations.
- there are already a number of licensed premises on the street including two public houses, numerous restaurants, as well as other social clubs. The addition of another licensed premises would not provide any additional benefit to the street and I believe would have a detrimental effect.
- I would be very concerned about the increase in noise and anti social behaviour with the introduction of alcohol. The road has a good mix of residential and business property and suffers from noise issues at present, so I don't believe an additional licensed premises will help in this matter. I also would anticipate the club being used for late night private functions as a result of an alcohol license, as has been observed on occasion in the 8 years I've lived on the road. This would bring in further unwelcome noise and anti social behaviour which can extend to beyond 11pm.
- specifically with regards to this premises the gentlemen who frequent it tend to sit outside in the lowered outside area. As well as being constantly observed as I come and go in xxxx I have noticed that many people, particularly women, would appear uncomfortable when passing this predominantly male club (except for one lady who works there). I don't believe the inclusion of alcohol will help in this regard.

I hope in reviewing this application you will take on board my concerns above, and I would also ask that my objection is kept confidential.

With reference to the above application, I am writing to inform you that the Metropolitan Police, as a Responsible Authority, will be objecting to this application as it is our belief that if granted the application would undermine the Licensing Objectives, being the Prevention of Crime and Disorder.

There are a number of licensed and unlicensed venues in the Newington Green area which police are aware are used for gambling. There are also intelligence reports linking various like venues to criminal gangs.

An email was sent to the applicant on the 28th of August 2014 requesting they accept our comprehensive wording to their CCTV condition. Since then a number of enquiries have taken place and it has been discovered that there are restricted criminal intelligence reports relating to the venue which give cause for concern over certain people linked with the venue.

We were hoping that the applicant would reply and that we could commence communication regarding the application and voice our concerns over these certain persons. To date there has been no communication back from the applicant whatsoever.

It is for these reasons that we are objecting to the application and propose that it is refused.

Appendix 3

- 1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirement of a Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Officer. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period as required by the Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Officer. Recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of the Police or authorised officer.
- 2. Only alcoholic drinks which are detailed on invoices will be purchased or accepted as part of a 'free' offer. Invoices (or copies) for all alcoholic goods on the premises will be made available to officers from the council, police or HMRC upon request.
- 3. No off sales permitted.
- 4. No vertical drinking permitted on the premises.
- 5. The licensee shall display a notice at the exit of the premises requesting customers leave the local area quietly.
- 6. No alcoholic drinks are permitted in the outside areas.
- 7. No entry for under 21 year olds.
- 8. The licensee shall adopt the Challenge 25 and the BII National Standards Proof of Age Scheme
- 9. The licensee shall ensure that staff are trained about the age limit for alcohol; the difficulty of accurately assessing age; acceptable 'proof of age' documents; and how to challenge for proof of age and how to refuse sales where necessary. The licensee shall further ensure that employees sign to confirm that they have understood the training. The licensee shall keep records of training and instruction given to staff.
- 10. The licensee and staff should note any refusals to sell to young people in a refusals log. The refusals log shall be checked and signed monthly by the designated premises supervisor. The refusals log shall be made available for inspection by the licensing team, police or trading standards.

Conditions suggested by the Noise Service (Agreed)

- 1. No refuse or waste collections to bne carried out between 22:00 and 07:00 and anytime on Sunday or Bank Holidays.
- 2. Noise and vibration from the ventilation or extract systems shall not be allowed to emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties.
- 3. All ventilation and extract systems shall be designed and maintained so as to prevent noxious smells causing a nuisance to nearby properties.
