Subject: Temporary Event Notice
Premises: Theatre Delicatessen, 119 Farringdon Road, London EC1R 3DA

1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is a hearing to consider two temporary event notices applied for under section 100, Part 5 of the licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The notices are to authorise the provision of regulated entertainment between 19:00 and 22:30 on 2nd to 6th June and 8th to 13th June 2015, throughout the premises, including the roof.
- 1.3 The notices are subject to two representations from the Council's Environmental Health Service on the grounds of public nuisance and public safety respectively.

3. Background

3.1 Papers are attached as follows:-

- Appendix 1: application forms;
- Appendix 2: representations;
- Appendix 3: premises licence and map of premises location.

3.2 Representations have been submitted by the Council's Environmental Health Service relating to public nuisance and public safety.

3.3 The premises is currently licensed from the basement to the fifth floor, however at this stage only the basement and ground floor have been approved for use under the licence. The roof area is not licensed.

3.4 The applicants are attending a meeting with officers from Environmental Health, Building Control, Fire Safety and Licensing on 11 May 2015 to discuss officer concerns.

4 Planning implications

4.1 Planning have reported that planning is due to be approved and is pending the issue of a formal decision. A "one off" use of the roof is unlikely to require planning consent, but if the use were to become regular or complaints received then the use of the roof would need to be reassessed.

5 Recommendations

5.1 To determine the application for temporary event notices under Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003.

5.2 The Committee can decide to:

- i. permit the TEN
- ii. permit the TEN, subject to one or more conditions of the current premises licence
- iii. not permit the TEN.

6. Conclusion and reasons for recommendations



The Premises is a multi-use creative workspace covering 6 floors. The ground floor and basement our multi-purpose performance spaces including a studio theatre, Cabaret space, and flexible immersive performances spaces. Floors 1-5 are rehearsal and development spaces and creative workspace and offices.

Describe the nature of the event below (see also guidance on completing the form, note 5)

Shelter Me will be a promenade, site-specific performance. It is being created for the former Guardian Building, and will take the audience on a journey from the basement to the roof of the building. In doing so, the performers will make full use of the currently licensed spaces within the building, which have been approved previously by Islington Council. In addition, we are looking for a variation to the existing premises licence to enable the audience to travel across the open area of the 6th floor, and observe a final aerial act. This walkway is not currently included in the public demise of the current premises licence.

AUDIENCE JOURNEY

- The total audience capacity for the production is 80 people
- The performance will begin in the southside of the basement - cafe space
- This will also serve as the audience bar / cafe, in line with our current licence conditions
- The performance will continue to the north side of the basement, again in line with existing licence conditions and previous use
- Audience groups will then be shepherded to the 5th floor by means of the lifts
- This will be the first usage of the 5th floor for public access
- For this performance, a specific 32 Amp electricity feed has been installed, so as to avoid using existing electrical systems
- This installation has been certified, and the temporary lighting installation that it will power will be PAT tested
- From the vantage point of the 5th floor, the audience will view a performance which will be taking place on the roof of a building on the opposite side of the road.
- Following this, the audience will be guided by ushers through the internal staircase to the open 6th floor, where they will view the final aerial performance
- The dwell time on the open 6th floor will be no more than 20 minutes, and will occur at a fixed time each evening

TRUSS STRUCTURE - 6TH FLOOR

The finale of Shelter Me will take place on 6th floor of the building, in an open area. This area has been identified by the Head of Rigging at the National Centre of Circus Arts as the ideal placement for both maximum impact and health and safety. The Truss will be anchored to the structural fixings which were utilised by the (now unused) water tank system. The 8m x 8m Truss will not extend beyond the height of the existing plant machinery on the roof, and so will not affect the visual profile of the building.

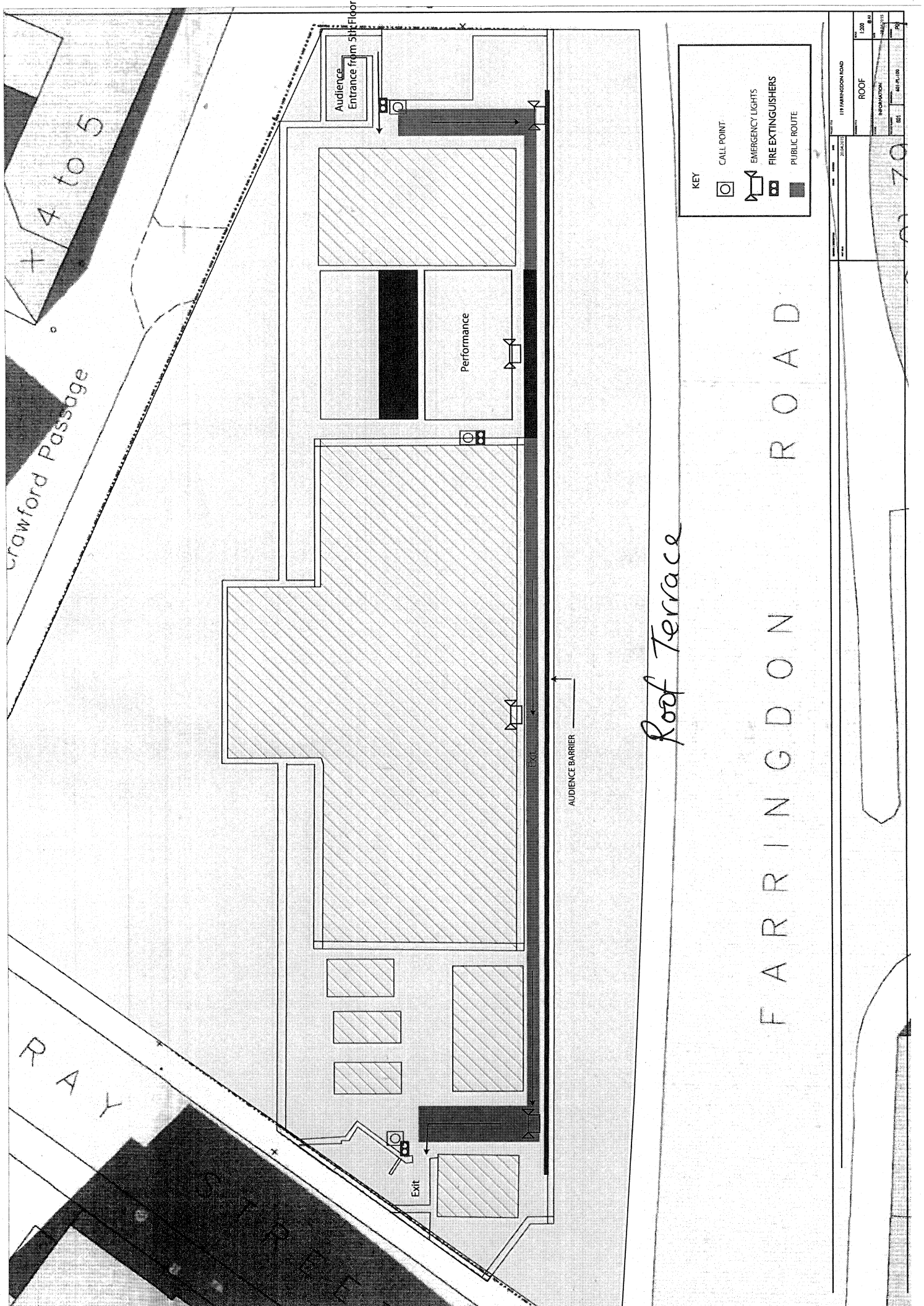

I would like to object to the two TEN applications in respect of this premises for 2 to 6 June and 8 to 13 June 2015.

There is insufficient information provided concerning the location of this event. The application states that the event will take place on the North side of the ground floor, however, under the description of the event, reference is made to use of the 5th floor and roof area. Furthermore reference is made to a performance on the roof of another building but no details are provided about the location or nature of this performance.

If the applicants are proposing to use the 5th floor of the building, this is yet to be approved for use under the premises licence and the roof is not part of the current licensed area. Assuming these areas are to be used, I have concerns relating to the public safety objective. Insufficient information has been provided at this stage outlining the planned checks and measures to ensure the safety of the public.

I understand that the operators will be meeting with officers from Building Control, Fire Safety and Licensing to provide further details, and more detailed risk assessments will be provided.

I recommend that these TENs be refused unless the applicants are able to provide sufficient information confirming the precise location of the event spaces and demonstrate that adequate checks have been made and control measures will be in place to minimise the risk to public safety.

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. All door supervisors shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
4. The admission of children to the exhibition of a film shall be restricted in accordance with the recommendation of a film classification body as defined in the Video Recordings Act 1984 or Islington Council acting as the licensing authority where it has given notice in section 20(3) of the Licensing Act 2003.

There are further 'Mandatory conditions' applicable to licences authorising the supply of alcohol. A full list of the current mandatory conditions is available from the licensing pages on Islington's web site, www.islington.gov.uk. This list is subject to change by order of the Secretary of State and licensees and other responsible persons are advised to ensure they are aware of the latest conditions.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. The building shall be managed by a team of on-site staff at all times, comprising a building supervisor who will be stationed at the front desk, front of house staff overseeing public access to performances and bar staff supervising the bar/café area.
2. Staff shall be able to communicate using radios. All will be trained in evacuation procedures with regular 'drills' being held so that all are aware of their responsibilities should evacuation of the building become necessary.
3. All entrances and exits shall be covered by CCTV cameras, with staff trained to download relevant footage if required by authorities.
4. Audience numbers shall be strictly limited.
5. The licensing authority shall be notified of the staging of new theatre productions, including providing plans of changes in set and layout of performance spaces.
6. The entrance to the building will always be manned by a member of staff, to ensure only those people who are using the café/bar or are in possession of a ticket for a theatre performance are allowed access.
7. The sale or supply of alcohol at the premises shall be at all times ancillary to the provision of regulated entertainment.
8. There shall be no sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises.
9. No one who appears to be drunk or intoxicated shall be served alcohol by bar staff.
10. Staff shall challenge anyone who looks under 21 years to prove their age by presentation of recognised identification.
11. Public access areas will be clearly signed, and no members of the public will be admitted to "private areas". This will be managed by a team of Front of House staff.
12. Public access to the building shall be limited to the numbers specified below:

For large scale productions Theatre Delicatessen will utilise either the Lower Ground Floor or Fifth Floor. These spaces shall not be used concurrently.

13. Only members of the public who bought a ticket for a performance shall have access to the promenade performance space.
14. The means of escape provided for the premises shall be maintained unobstructed, free of trip hazards, be immediately available and clearly identified in accordance with the plans provided.
15. All exit doors shall be available at all times without the use of a key, code, card or similar means.
16. All emergency doors shall be maintained effectively self-closing and not held open other than by an approved device.
17. Children under the age of 12 shall not be admitted to the building unless accompanied by a responsible adult.
18. Ticket sales to theatre productions dealing with issues of an adult nature shall be restricted to over 16 year olds.
19. A detailed scheme of sound insulation works and measures shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Council's Pollution Team. The approved details shall be implemented in full prior to the commencement of the premises licence.
20. Noise or vibration shall not emanate from any fixed plant or equipment associated with the premises so as to cause a nuisance to the neighbours.
21. Music shall not be played at a level that will cause unreasonable disturbance to the occupants of any properties in the vicinity.
22. Except for access and egress all doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment and/or rehearsals are taking place, and in any event after 21:00.
23. No speakers will be placed in the entrance lobby, outside the premises nor on the outside of any building forming part of the premises.
24. The Premises Licence Holder will prepare and implement a dispersal policy to the written approval and satisfaction of the Council's Pollution Team.
25. A specific taxi operator will be nominated for staff and customers use. The company's telephone number will be advertised to customers. The operator and all drivers will be made aware that they should arrive and depart as quietly as possible, should not sound vehicle horns as a signal of their arrival or leave engines idling unnecessarily. In addition, staff will leave as quietly as possible, particularly at night and early in the morning.
26. A telephone number shall be made available and displayed in prominent locations in for local residents to contact in the case of noise-nuisance or anti-social behaviour by persons or activities associated with the premises. The number shall be direct to the management who are in control during the premises opening hours.

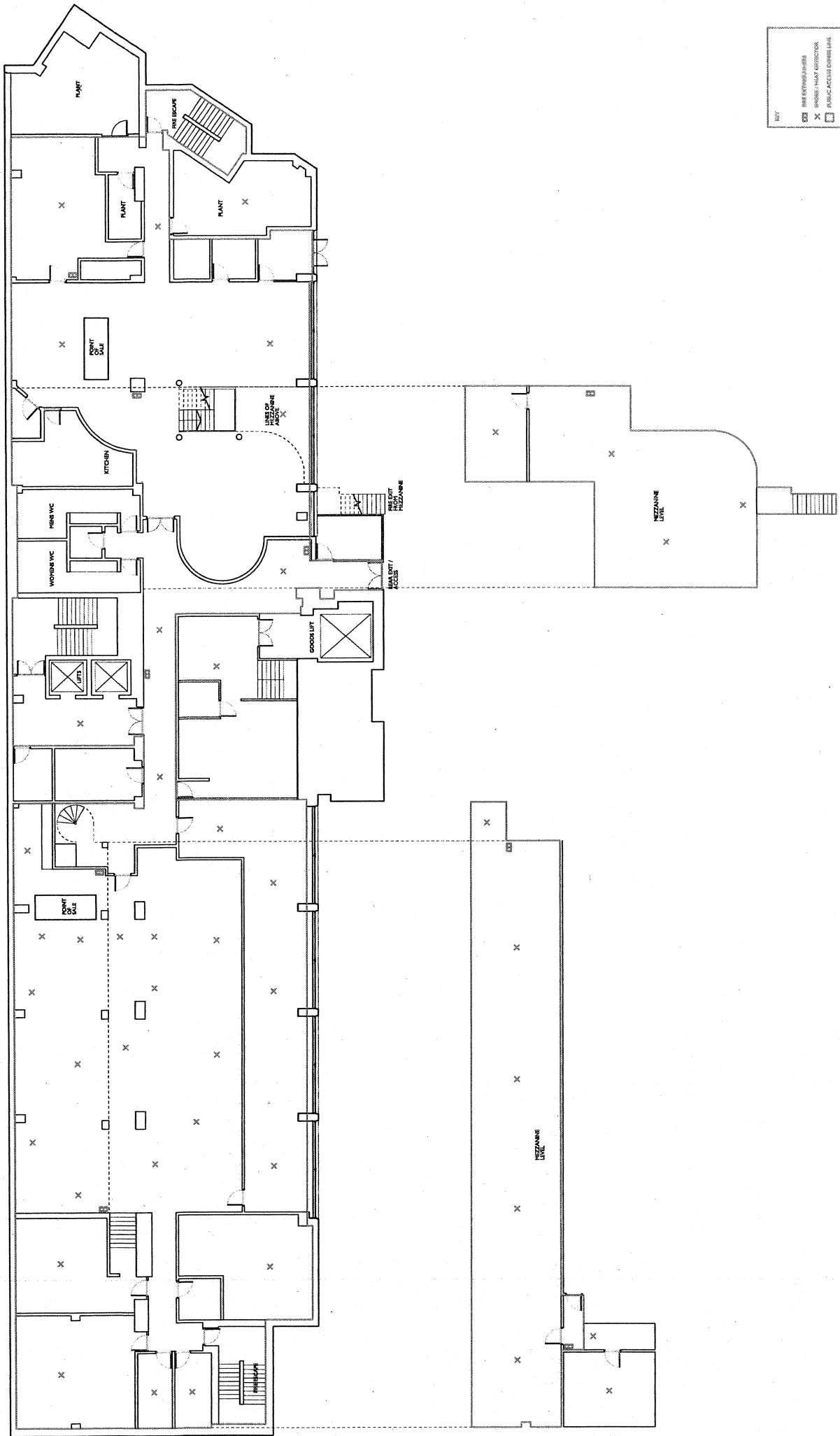
27. The designated smoking area shall be limited to the area at the front of the building indicated by signage and ground markings.
28. Patrons permitted to smoke at the designated smoking area shall be limited to 12 persons at any one time.
29. The designated smoking area shall not be used for the consumption of drinks.
30. Suitable receptacles shall be provided for cigarette litter at the designated smoking area.
31. The designated smoking area shall be closed and cleared of patrons by 00:00. Notices shall be displayed to inform patrons of this requirement.
32. Notices shall be prominently displayed at the designated smoking area requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and use the area quietly.
33. The disposal of empty bottles into outdoor storage receptacles will not take place on Sundays or Bank Holidays and between the hours of 19:00 and 08:00 hours other days of the week.
34. No deliveries will take place on Sundays or Bank Holidays and between the hours of 19:00 and 08:00 hours other days of the week.
35. The windows and other glazed areas to the premises shall be fitted with heavy duty curtains or similar to prevent light breakout from strobe or other flashing lights equipment.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

1. The arrangements at the premises, including means of escape provisions, emergency warning equipment, the electrical installation and mechanical equipment shall be subject to Council approval and shall at all times be maintained in good condition and full working order.
2. Anyone purchasing alcohol who appears to be under 25 years will be asked for ID to prove they are over 18 years.
3. Fireworks or other pyrotechnics will not be used other than with the prior consent of the Council.
