Wherever possible, unsuccessful applicants will be supported, to secure alternative premises for their work.

Some of the proposals received did not make the most effective use of the high quality technical facilities and the audience capacity of the Assembly Hall. It was considered that some of these might be better staged in smaller or more appropriate venues, such as one of Islington Town Hall's committee rooms, or the Platform and White Lion Youth hubs. This could also help applicants to develop mutually beneficial partnerships with partner organisations with similar objectives and remits.
