

PREMISES LICENCE NEW APPLICATION

RE: FOOD LAB, 56-58 ESSEX ROAD, LONDON, N1 8LR

### 1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is an application for a new premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The new application is to:
  - i) Allow the sale by retail of alcohol, Monday to Wednesday 07:00 to 23:00, Thursday to Saturday 07:00 to 24:00.
  - ii) Recorded music (background levels) Monday to Wednesday 08:00 to 19:00, Thursday to Saturday 08:00 to 23:00 and Sunday 10:00 to 22:00.
  - iii) Late night refreshments Thursday to Saturday 23:00 to 24:00.

### 2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the application for a new premises licence under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
  - i. conditions of the current premises licence;
  - ii. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (See appendix 3)
  - iii. any conditions deemed necessary by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

## 3. Background

- 3.1 The applicant currently holds the Premises Licence for 56 Essex Road which permits
  - 3.1.1 On and off sales of alcohol on Sunday to Wednesday 07:00 to 23:00 and Thursday to Saturday 07:00 to 24:00.
  - 3.1.2 Late night refreshment Thursday to Saturday 23:00 to 24:00.
- 3.2 The licensee for 56 Essex Road has purchased 58 Essex Road and has expanded her business to make one larger unit.

### **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence
  - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3. All door supervisors shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

### Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1. Any incidents of crime and disorders shall be recorded in a log and reported to the Police.
- 2. The premises shall have a documented health and safety policy.
- 3. An alcohol free area of the premises shall be reserved for families.
- 4. All staff shall be trained in food hygiene.
- 5. The sale of alcohol on the premises shall be ancillary to food.
- 6. Incident and refusals book to be kept and completed at the premise.

We the undersigned residents, through the residents committee wish to provide representation and objection to the application for a Premises License to Food Lab 56/58 Essex Rd (ref WK/121358664)

We would firstly wish to point out that the original planning application for a change of use was for 56 Essex Rd from A1 use to A3 use (solely!!), received on the 25/04/2003 we believe this application was refused due to the lack of adequate ventilation provision within the planning application.

We are also in receipt of a letter from the Old Street Housing Office dated 25th November 2011 from Johanna Roberts (Estates Services Coordinator) that states that 56 Essex Rd is registered as a shop and not a restaurant

Recently this business which was a small coffee shop has morphed and expanded its kitchen and floor space into the adjoining property 58 Essex Rd which now provides over 20 covers inside and 40 covers on the street outside (with wooden perimeter stockade area extending at least 4m beyond the shop front and encompassing the whole width of these two shop fronts (at least 8m)

Our objection to the application is in relation to the increase in ASB, noise and nuisance to the residents above these premises and the loss of amenity due to the noise and odours which have increased proportionally with the expansion of this business.

We respectfully request this application is rejected until a Senior EHO has visited these premises and provides written advice on the nuisance being caused and suggested abatement measures to minimise noise and odour nuisance to the residents above.

We would further respectfully request this letter is forwarded to the Environmental Health Team, and Building Control Team and this application is refused until the advice and guidance is sought and included prior to any approval, we believe this business is operating outside of the terms of its lease and is now causing a statutory nuisance

We would further request that any future applications for a Premises License to serve food and drink with extended opening hours to 56 & 58 Essex Rd include a caveat that these premises shall not be used as a nightclub, music or dance venue without prior permission of the Local Authorising Authority

Could you please acknowledge receipt of this email and confirm this is being accepted as our objection.



### CONDITIONS:

1 The retrospective A3 cafe/restaurant use hereby approved is only approved for a limited period of two years from the date of the decision and shall cease to be the authorised use thereafter. (11 June 2015)

REASON: In the interests of protecting the amenity of the surrounding residential properties and with regard to the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (Amendment) (England) Order 2013.

2 DRAWING AND DOCUMENT NUMBERS: The development hereby approved shall be carried out in accordance with the following approved plans:

REASON: To comply with Section 70(1)(a) of the Town and Country Act 1990 as amended and the Reason for Grant and also for the avoidance of doubt and in the interest of proper planning.

3 HOURS OF OPERATION (COMPLIANCE): The ground floor unit at 56-58 Essex Road hereby approved shall not operate outside the hours of:

08:00 - 23:00 Monday to Saturday 08:00 - 22:00 On Sundays

REASON: To ensure that the proposed development does not have an adverse impact on neighbouring residential amenity in accordance with policies: DM2.1 the Islington

Development Policies 2013 and policy CS12F of the Islington Core Strategy 2011.

The design and installation of new items of fixed plant shall be such that when operating the cumulative noise level LAeq Tr arising from the proposed plant, measured or predicted at 1m from the facade of the nearest noise sensitive premises, shall be a rating level of at least 5dB(A) below the background noise level LAF90?Tbg. The measurement and/or prediction of the noise should be carried out in accordance with the methodology contained within BS 4142: 1997.

REASON: In the interests of protecting the amenity of the surrounding residential properties.

Your attention is drawn to any INFORMATIVES that may be listed below

- A flexible skirt should be fitted either side of the extract fan within the premises? The complete isolation of the ducting at all points of fixings from the extract hood, via the fan, internal route and external by anti-vibration mounts. (All fixings will have to be treated). Ensure the ducting and motor are not touching any structure. Cylindrical ducting to external is fitted (to stop drumming effect of panels of rectangular duct) The plant and equipment shall be serviced regularly in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and as necessary to ensure that the requirements of the condition are maintained. The accompanying information does not mention an in-line attenuator and the applicant is advised that this may be required in order to meet the requirements of this condition.
- 2 To assist applicants in a positive manner, the Local Planning Authority has produced policies and written guidance, all of which is available on the Council's website.
  A pre-application advice service is also offered and encouraged.
  Whilst no pre-application discussions were entered into, the policy advice and guidance available on the website was followed by the applicant.
  The applicant therefore worked in a proactive manner taking into consideration the policies and guidance available to them.

## Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule

- 1. Alcoholic and other drinks purchased from the premise shall not be taken away from the immediate curtilege of the premise in open containers.
- 2. Any incidences of crime and disorder shall be recorded in a log and reported to the Police.
- 3. The premises shall have a documented health and safety policy.
- 4. All exit routes shall be kept unobstructed, with non slippery and even surfaces, free of trip hazards and clearly identified.
- 5. All staff must be trained in food hygiene.
- 6. Drinks to be only served when customers are seated and taking meals.
- 7. Noise and vibration must not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties.
- 8. Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premise and the area quietly.
- 9. No rubbish including bottles will be moved, removed or placed in outside areas on Sundays or Bank Holidays and between the hours of 9pm and 8am other days of the week.
- 10. An alcohol free area of the premises shall be reserved for families.
- 11. Premises to adopt Challenge 21, The National Proof Of Age Standards Scheme.
- 12. A written record of refused sales shall be kept on the premises and completed when necessary. This record shall be made available to Police and/ or Local Authority officers upon request.
- 13. Staff will be fully trained in dealing with drunk customers and a record of the training will be kept on the premises.
