In accordance with section 29 (1), I am writing to give you notice that the above case will be returned to the next meeting of the Licensing and Regulatory Committee with a recommendation that your licence be revoked.

This is on the grounds that: (as per section 28 (1) (h))

The licence holder has persistently failed to comply with any condition of her licence

At the meeting of the 6th October 2009 the Committee agreed that your licence would not be revoked but that a condition be added 'that the receptacle to be used for trading in Whitecross Street Market will be a canopy'. This condition was to take effect within seven days. A letter confirming this outcome was sent to you dated 12th October and confirmed again by email to your solicitors on 26th and the 29th October 2009. Despite this, you are still trading from a trailer.

You are invited to attend the meeting bringing with you any legal representative you may so wish. Please see the reverse of this letter for details of the meeting.
