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Subject: PREMISES LICENCE VARIATION APPLICATION
La Forchetta, 92 Cowcross Street, London EC1M

1. Synopsis

- 1.1 This is an application for the variation of a premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.
- 1.2 The variation application is to:
 - a) Allow the premises to be used for the sale of alcohol, for consumption on the premises only, between 11:00 and 22:30 on Mondays to Saturdays and between 11:00 and 22:00 on Sundays.
- 1.3 The premises is currently licensed to:
 - a) Supply Late Night Refreshment, Fridays to Sundays, from 23:00 to 05:00.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To determine the application for a variation of the premises licence under Section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003.

- 2.2 If the Committee grants the application it should be subject to:
- i. conditions prepared by the Licensing Officer which are consistent with the Operating Schedule (See appendix 4);
 - ii. conditions recommended by responsible Authorities (see appendix 4); and
 - iii. any conditions deemed appropriate by the Committee to promote the four licensing objectives.

3. Background

- 3.1 Papers are attached as follows:-

Appendix 1: application form;
Appendix 2: representations;
Appendix 3: current premises licence;
Appendix 4: suggested conditions and map of premises location.

- 3.2 The premises is located within the Bunhill and Clerkenwell Cumulative Impact Policy area, adopted by the Council on 24 January 2013.

- 3.3 The Licensing Authority has received two representations to this application. One from the Metropolitan Police and one from a local resident, who has requested anonymity. The Licensing Service has requested that the Metropolitan Police supply more information in support of their representation. A further representation from the Health and Safety Officer has been withdrawn on the basis that his proposed conditions have been agreed by the applicant.

4. Planning Implications

- 4.1 There Planning Service has reported that:

"Planning records indicate no planning permission has been sought or obtained for the premises to operate as a restaurant (A3 use). The only permission I was able to find is in relation to a planning permission (attached) that was obtained in 1962 for the premises to operate as a betting office (A2). Within this context, no comments can be made to the variation of the hours of licence premises.

The enforcement team will be opening a new enforcement case file for the matter to be investigated.

If the applicant requires formal confirmation that no planning permission is needed for the activities described in the licence application, they are recommended to submit an application for a certificate of lawfulness under Sections 191-2 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended)."

- 4.2 The applicants have been advised by the Licensing Service to contact the Planning Service and seek a certificate of lawfulness as recommended by the Planning Service.

5. Conclusion and reasons for recommendations

- 5.1 The Council is required to consider this application in the light of all relevant information, and if approval is given, it may attach such conditions as considered appropriate to promote the licensing objectives.

The DP will take full responsibility to ensure that all staff is fully trained with a comprehensive knowledge of challenge 25 and licensing issues under the 2003 licensing Act this training will be fully documented and refreshed every six months.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises License holder WILL install CCTV that follows DCMS guidelines for camera systems in licensed premises which covers all licensed areas of the premises. The system will records for 31 days and all recordings will be made available to the police upon request. At least one member of staff will have training on the full workings of the system. Signage is in place to inform members of the public of the CCTV system is in operation.
There will always be a Personal Licence holder on the premises throughout the time that licensable activity is taking place to authorise any sales or alcohol.

c) Public safety

The installed digital CCTV system will record for 31 days all public areas of the premises which will monitor all public safety issues. The DP will be responsible to carry out a fire and health and safety risk assessments for licensed premises all notices in relation to public health and safety will be displayed.
The DP will ensure that the premises operates in line with existing health and safety legislation and is aware that it is also the responsibility of the premises licence holder that this legislation is adhered to.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The DP and the Premises Licence holder are responsible for ensuring that the premises do not cause any nuisance to the local residents, other business operators or the general public. They will monitor the external areas of the premises in relation to public nuisance or antisocial behaviour. Deliveries and rubbish collections will only take place during normal business hours and are at the rear of the premises Any antisocial behaviour CCTV recordings will be made available to the police and environmental health officers.
Signage requesting that patrons respect that it is a residential area please leave quietly.

The DPS will ensure that all staff receives fully documented training in relation to Challenge 25 and the licensing Objectives. I am writing to express concerns about a licence application variation for La Forchetta, 92 Cowcross Street, London EC1M 6BH. La Forchetta is applying for the right to sell alcohol seven days a week.

I am a resident of _____. I would also like my identity to be kept private as I do not wish to be potentially subject to any harassment by the proprietors of La Forchetta.

The neighbourhood already suffers from chronic noise pollution overnight on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays as a result of the nightclub, Fabric, around the corner. Making alcohol available for consumption -- even if it's on the premises only at La Forchetta -- would mean more individuals would loiter on the street and lead directly to a higher incidence of disruptive public behaviour.

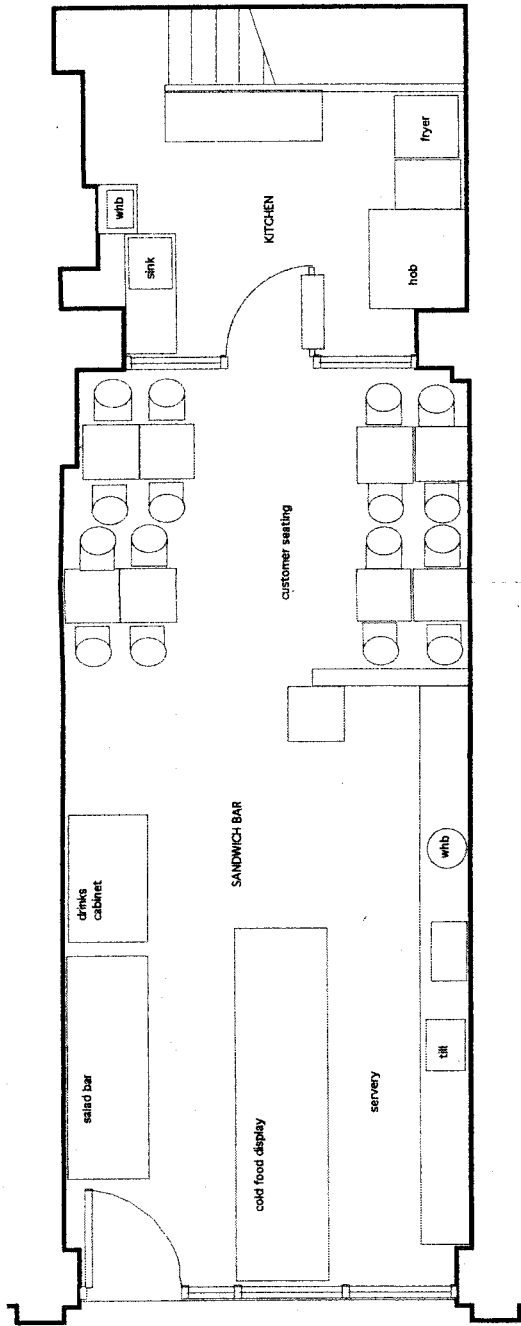

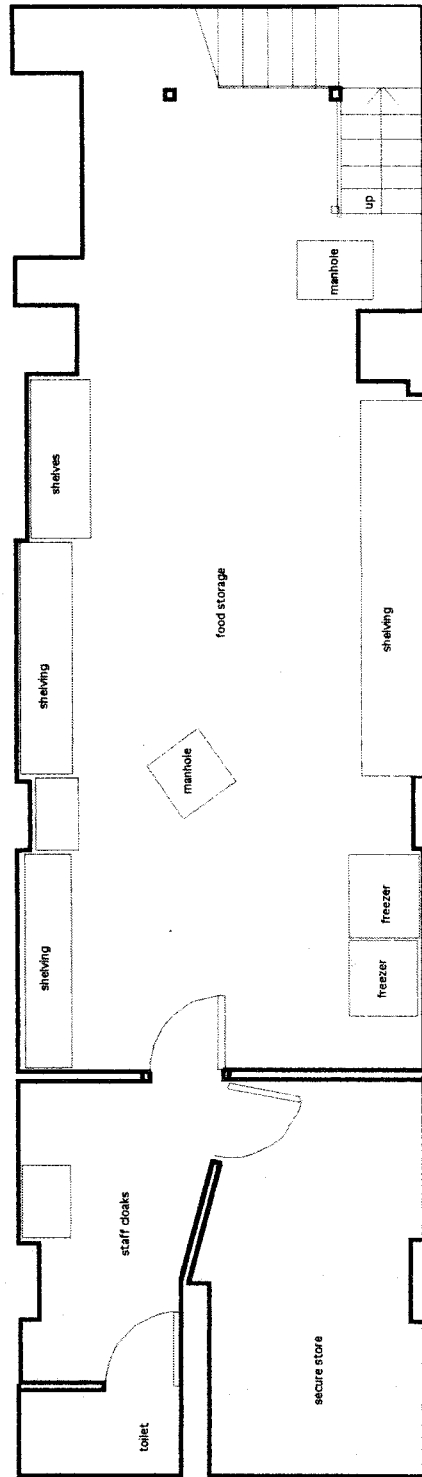

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Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule

1. Alcohol shall only be served ancillary to a table meal.
2. No vertical drinking of alcohol shall be permitted.
3. All alcohol shall be served at the table only.
4. CCTV shall be installed covering all licensed areas of the premises. The system shall record a minimum of 31 days and all recordings shall be available to police on request. At least one member of staff shall have training on the full workings of the system. Signage shall be in place to inform members of the public that a CCTV is operation.
5. There shall be a personal licence holder on the premises throughout the time that licensable activity is taking place to authorise any sales of alcohol.
6. The DPS shall be responsible for carrying out fire and health and safety risk assessments for licensed premises and all notices in relation to public health and safety shall be displayed. The DPS and premises licence holder shall be responsible for ensuring that the premises operates in line with existing health and safety legislation.
7. The DPS and premises licence holder shall be responsible for ensuring that the premises do not cause any nuisance to the local residents, other business operators or the general public. They will monitor outside areas of the premises in relation to public nuisance and antisocial behaviour. Deliveries and rubbish collections shall only take place during normal business hours and take place from the rear of the premises. Any CCTV recordings of antisocial behaviour shall be made available to the police and environmental health officers.
8. Signage requesting that patrons "Respect that this is a residential area, please leave quietly", shall be displayed.
9. The DPS shall ensure that all staff members receive fully documented training in relation to "Challenge 25" and the Licensing Objectives.
10. A refusal book shall be kept on the premises for inspection by the authorities.
11. All necessary signage shall be displayed with regard to "Challenge 25" and the fact that a "No ID, no sale" policy is in place.

Suggested conditions of approval recommended by the health and public safety officer

12. The premises shall not be used under the variation to the licence until the requirements specified in the schedule dated 6 August 2013 have been completed and approved in writing by the responsible authority for health and public safety.
