Costs

- There may be some costs associated with booking time in the community centres for venue hire
- Some small costs may be incurred in each centre in relation to any new storage facilities or programme equipment or health and safety requirements.

Associated conversations

- Initial feedback from Age UK is that their volunteers / service providers may be happy to re locate to other centres.
- Consideration is needed on how these activities would be managed and coordinated. This may require a budget for governance/volunteer and programme management, marketing, attendance figures and impact reports.
- New service user agreements would take place with individual centres for usual checks including risk assessments, storage, public liability, DBS and payments direct to centres.
- There may be opportunities to create flexible community spaces to enable drop-in sessions to be run to support social inclusion, as some centres have considerable underutilized time
