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SUBJECT: SUMMARY REVIEW APPLICATION
PREMISES: Orleans 259-261 Seven Sisters Road London N4 2DD

Synopsis

- 1.1 In accordance with Section 53a of Licensing Act 2003 the premises licence was the subject of an expedited / summary review application by the Metropolitan Police on 30th December 2019.
- 1.2 This application was in relation to the following licencing objective, after an incident in the early hours of Christmas Day:
 - Serious crime
- 1.3 At 13:00 on the 30th December 2019 the Licensing Sub-Committee considered whether it was necessary to take interim steps pending a full licence review. The Sub-Committee took into account the oral and written representations from the police.
- 1.4 The Sub-Committee decided to suspend the licence for Orleans, 259 – 261 Seven Sisters Road, N4 2DD with immediate effect, for a period of 28 days, as an interim measure pending a full review hearing.
- 1.5 On 7th January 2020 the premises licence holder submitted representations against the interim steps but subsequently withdrew them.
- 1.6 Unless the licence holder submits further representations, the interim steps imposed on the 30th December 2019 will remain in force until review hearing. Having considered the evidence, the Sub-Committee is required to review the interim steps and consider whether it is appropriate, for the promotion of the licensing objectives, for the interim steps to remain in place or if they should be modified or withdrawn.

Recommendations

- 2.1 To consider the application to review the premises licence under Section 53A of the Licensing Act 2003 and, having regard to the application and any relevant representations, determine
- what steps are considered appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives; and
 - decide if the interim steps cease to have effect
- 2.2 The steps appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives are:
- a) to modify the conditions of the premises licence; by altering, omitting or adding any new conditions, including restricting times of any licensable activity
 - b) to exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence;
 - c) to remove the designated premises supervisor;
 - d) to suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months; and
 - e) to revoke the licence;
