Going forward all groups will be reported in the annual Education Outcomes Report.
28 th February 2023	Data on home educated families who went to university	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Progress Team provides support to Year 11 young people who are home educated throughout the year ensuring they have access to independent careers advice and guidance on their pathways and options Post 16. • The Progress team has a statutory duty to track young people's current destination in Year 12 and 13 and to provide wraparound support to those who are NEET. • There is no statutory duty beyond Year 13 to track young people therefore we are unable to provide data on home educated young people progressing to university.
28 th February 2023	The issue concerning the Health & Wellbeing survey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HWB survey: overall report and shorter summary produced and disseminated to all schools; event for all schools to understand the messages and how they could respond; participating schools received own data plus further Public Health analysis report showing how they compared to other schools on a range of questions • HWB team have met with individual participating schools to consider how they respond to the needs of their pupils identified through the survey, eg revising their PSHE curriculum, thinking about their food and water provision, considering how they support children's emotional health and wellbeing, or support the least active children to be more physically active; schools are encouraged to share the results with their pupils and families • the HWB team is compiling a leaflet for parents of key findings from the survey and how they can address the issues raised at home as well as at school • HWB team are working with leads in schools to consider how to feedback to pupils the results of the survey
