Recordable decision taken by: Director of Climate Change and Transport

Title of decision: Mildmay Liveable Neighbourhood – making of Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) relating to Newington Green walking, wheeling and cycling improvements and Mildmay Grove North loading bay

Date of decision	Wednesday 6 th November 2024
Description of decision taken	To agree to the proposal to make TMOs relating to two schemes within the Mildmay Liveable Neighbourhood (LN) projects: the Newington Green walking, wheeling and cycling improvements, and the Mildmay Grove North loading bay.
Reasons for decision	<p>The Mildmay LN Officer Key Decision Report October 2024 approved the implementation of the Mildmay LN project and its component schemes following public engagement to inform development of proposals between 2021 and 2024 and consultation on final proposals in September-October 2023. The overall project will help deliver some of the council's key objectives, including those set out in the council's Transport Strategy and Vision 2030.</p> <p>The Newington Green walking, wheeling and cycling scheme for which this decision approves the making of Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) will deliver significant improvements in walking, wheeling and cycling safety around Newington Green. The cycleway will enable people to cycle safely across the busy gyratory and will provide a link between two disconnected cycle routes adjoining the project area, enabling longer onward cycle journeys. The scheme will also enable a safe route for children to walk, wheel and cycle to the planned relocated entrance to Newington Green Primary School, on Mildmay Road. and will improve safety for people walking and wheeling by reducing vehicle speeds, narrowing pedestrian crossing distances, and improving sightlines at nine zebra crossings around the Green.</p> <p>The two schemes will also benefit residents and businesses by providing improved loading facilities on the west side of Newington</p>

	Green, and on the corner of Mildmay Grove North and Mildmay Park.
Other options considered	<p>TMOs relating specifically to the Newington Green walking, wheeling and cycling improvements, and the Mildmay Grove North loading bay, underwent statutory consultation between 11 October and 1 November 2024. There were no responses from statutory consultees during arising from this.</p> <p>The following options were considered in relation to this decision:</p> <p>Option 1: Do not make TMOs, as advertised in the statutory consultation from 11 October to 1 November</p> <p>Option 2: Make TMOs, as advertised in the statutory consultation from 11 October to 1 November</p> <p>The council decided to proceed with Option 2.</p>
