1. Synopsis

1.1 This is an application for the variation of a premise licence under the Licensing Act 2003.

1.2 The premises currently holds a licence allowing:

- The provision of Late Night Refreshment, Sundays to Thursdays from 23:00 until 00:00 and Fridays & Saturdays from 23:00 until 01:00 the following day; and
- The premises to be open to the public, Sundays to Thursdays from 12:00 until 00:00 and Fridays & Saturdays from 12:00 until 01:00 the following day.

1.3 The variation application is to allow:

- The provision of Late Night Refreshment, Sundays from 23:00 until 00:00, Mondays to Thursdays from 23:00 until 01:00 the following day and Fridays & Saturdays from 23:00 until 02:00 the following day; and
- The premises to be open to the public, Sundays from 12:00 until 00:00, Mondays to Thursdays from 12:00 until 01:00 the following day and Fridays & Saturdays from 12:00 until 02:00 the following day.





Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. CCTV system shall be installed and maintained inside and outside the premises, including a CCTV unit, which monitors the immediate vicinity of the premises. All cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and the video recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with time and date stamping. Tape recordings shall be made available to an authorised officer or a police officer with 24 hours of any request. Notices informing the public that CCTV is in operation will be placed in the windows of the premises.
2. Notices informing the public that no alcohol is being sold or supplied at the premises will be placed in the windows of the premises.
3. Staff from the premises will ensure that the area in and around the premises is clear of litter.
4. Staff only areas will be clearly marked as private.
5. Any instances of crime and disorder at the premises shall be reported to the Police immediately, record of these incidents shall be kept in a general incident *log-book* in which are recorded details of each day's events. This log shall be made available to an authorised officer or a police officer with 24 hours of any request.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

1. The extraction system shall be maintained in good condition so as not to cause noise nuisance to neighbouring residents.

I wish to **ANONYMOUSLY** object to the application for extension of trading hours for the above venue. Anonymity is requested for safety reasons.

This is a residential area and for both crime and noise reasons we object.

Similar businesses a few shops down are attracting significant groups of violent fighting men and causing noise late at night. We have logged a number of complaints about these businesses.

For example please see Antisocial Behaviour Complaint reference number FI1600273 from 15th November 2015 where, outside this location, there was a large group of 10 fighting each other violently with weapons including hammers, male v male AND male v female violence, at 2am.

We find it frightening to live in this area with these incidences and do not want them encouraged.

More broadly, we have found that the businesses underneath our flats cause significant amounts of noise outside their licensed hours, please also see records of the AntiSocial Behaviour complaints log. We also wish to object on noise grounds.

Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule

1. CCTV shall be installed at the premises and will record at all times the premises is open for licensable activities. Recordings will be made available to Police and other authorised officers on request.
2. A CCTV monitor will be viewable by customers to remind customers that their image is being recorded.
3. First Aid box to be located at the service counter.
4. Signage will be displayed requesting all customers leave the shop and local area quietly.
5. Customers will be requested to dispose of their litter in the street bins outside or take it home with them.
6. No person under 16 shall be allowed on the premises without a parent or guardian.
7. No person under 16 will be allowed on the premises after 23:00.



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
