

Public Nuisance

WE ARE CONCERNED ABOUT NOISE+ DISORDER.

THE AREA IS ALREADY V. BUSY + NOISY ON MATCH DAYS - A LOT OF RUBBISH IN THE STREET IS CREATED TOO. TO HAVE A LICENSED PREMISE WOULD ENCOURAGE PEOPLE TO REMAIN IN THE AREA AFTER MATCHES AND CREATE MORE DISRUPTION. THE SALE OF FOOD ON THE STREET FROM MAMMA MIA, EL MOLINO + THE CHARITY LAND THE LOW MUSIC THEY PLAY) IS DISRUPTIME ADE RESIDENTS AS IT IS. GATEN MUSIC GOES ON TILLATE.

Suggested conditions of approval consistent with the operating schedule

- 1. The premises licence holder shall enforce the challenge 25 proof of age scheme.
- 2. CCTV shall be installed, operated and maintained in agreement with the Police. Maintained means that the system will be regularly serviced (at least once a year) and checked every two weeks to ensure that it is storing images correctly and a log kept and signed by a supervisor to this effect. The system will provide identifiable full frontal head and shoulder image of everyone entering the premises and will operate in any light conditions within the premises. The system will cover the full exterior of the premises and shall record in real time, date and time stamped and will operate whilst the premises is open for licensable activities. The recordings will be kept for a minimum of 31 days and copies will be made available to an Authorised officer or a police officer (subject to the Data protection Act 1998) within 24hrs of any request free of charge. There will always be a member of staff on duty who can operate the system, to allow officers to view recordings and if required by a Police Officer, provide a copy of images immediately free of charge to assist in the immediate investigation of offences. If the system malfunctions and will not be operating for longer than one day of business then Police must be informed
- 3. The supply of alcohol at the premises shall only be to a person seated taking a table meal there and for consumption by such a person as ancillary to their meal
- 4. The supply of alcohol shall be by waiter or waitress service only
- 5. There shall be a maximum of four tables outside with a maximum of 16 seats.
- 6. There shall be no vertical drinking.
- 7. All tables and chairs outside the venue will be made unusable by either stacking or turning upside down or relocating inside the venue by 21.00.
- 8. Deliveries and waste collections shall only be made between the hours of 07:00 and 22:00 hours, Monday to Sunday.
- 9. Notices shall be prominently displayed informing customers to leave the area quietly.
- 10. No drinks shall be taken outside the venue after 21.00.
