Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

There are further 'Mandatory conditions' applicable to licences authorising the supply of alcohol. A full list of the current mandatory conditions is available from the licensing pages on Islington's web site, www.islington.gov.uk. This list is subject to change by order of the Secretary of State and licensees and other responsible persons are advised to ensure they are aware of the latest conditions.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. Staff shall be trained to recognise and how to respond to inappropriate behaviour, the hours of alcohol sales and that there shall be no off sales of alcohol.
2. Exit doors shall be kept unlocked and clear during opening times.
3. Emergency exit lighting and fire safety equipment shall be install and maintained.
4. Staff shall be trained in emergency fire plans.
5. Rubbish shall be bagged and stored inside the premises and then put out for collection at the appropriate time.
6. The ventilating system shall be regularly cleaned and serviced and located away from neighbour's windows.
7. The noise from the ventilation system shall be kept to a minimum.
8. Customers shall be reminded as they leave not to disturb local residents.
9. Staff shall ensure that inappropriate behaviour, including swearing, shall not take place in the premises.
